¹ PY 2003 figures are preliminary only and do not include follow-up information for many exiters.

² As of PY 2001, Objective Assessment is no longer an acceptable exit category.

³ Beginning in PY 2001, employability enhancements were no longer a recognized category of exit. A somewhat similar concept, the achievement of an educational or occupational credential, is now captured in reporting but is not considered a valid category of exit. The number of credentials obtained is reported in this row for PY01-03.

⁴ For PY01-03, this represents the educational/occupational credential rate, rather than the enhancement rate, as noted above.
