PURPOSE: To inform the Office of Apprenticeship (OA), and State Apprenticeship Agency (SAA) staff of an addition to the Registered Apprenticeship Partners Information Data System (RAPIDS) for the coding and recording of a new occupational title for an existing occupation:

Die Manufacturer
Existing Title: Tool and Die Maker
O*NET-SOC Code: 51-4111.00
RAPIDS Code: 0586R-CL
Type of Training: Competency-based

BACKGROUND: Regional Executive Administrator Robert Laudeman submitted this occupation on behalf of the Department of Treasury, United States Mint. The Die Manufacturer has been recognized to meet the Manufacturing Industry demands for highly-skilled and highly-trained workers.

Since the two occupations are similar except for application within the Manufacturing Industry, O*NET determined it did not qualify for its own separate O*NET-SOC Code.

The suggested Work Process Schedule and Related Instruction Outlines are attached.
