POPULATION SERVED/RECRUITMENT: The Project will serve an all female population. The Statement of Work does not provide a projected number of participants. Nonetheless, it is expected as per the SGA, that a minimum of 88 participants will be served over a two year period of performance concluding March 31, 2010. Participants will be those women who are returning to urban areas of the state. The LSI-R will be administered by the Rhode Island Department of Corrections in order to design case management for each specific participant.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The PRI – Post Release Services project will hire a gender specific Reentry Specialist and an Employment Specialist to provide case management and mentoring services to support the participants. The Employment Specialist will provide job placement and retention services, connections to on the job training, basic skills remediation, outreach services with employers. Additionally, the Employment Specialist will coordinate services with the Reentry Specialist.

NON-FEDERAL MATCH: The Statement of Work does not indicate a non-federal match leveraged to support this project.

PARTNERS:

SUB-GRANTEE: The FBCO has not yet been selected.

OUTCOMES: The Statement of Work does not provide numerical goals for the project. Nonetheless the project will measure rate of retention of those employed, rate of recidivism, employment placement rate, and education attainment (as well as other outcome measures).

GEOGRAPHIC AREA TO BE SERVED: The three largest urban areas of Rhode Island: Providence, Pawtucket/Central Falls, and Woonsocket.
