PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Multi-faceted program in which re-entering offenders are offered transitional employment and receive concurrently assessment and case management, job readiness training, vocational/educational training and other support services prior to being permanently placed. Connections provides substance abuse and mental health treatment programs to its clientele. Housing will be provided through independent referrals, through the State Departments of Health and Social Services, and through housing partners. The Elizabeth House will partner with other faith-based and community organizations to carry out the mentoring component of the program.
