PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Jericho Program provides a reentry model that uses rapid attachments to work and leveraging of community assets. Through these partnerships, Jericho will provide employment readiness training and placement; access to educational opportunities; health and social services; housing assistance; and mentoring.



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
