# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Purpose of SGA



- Strengthen program administration
- Promote a more regionalized service delivery architecture
- Distribute resources more equitably
- Ensure free and open competition



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006

## What is SCSEP?



### Senior Community Service Employment Program

**Who:** unemployed, low income seniors 55+ with multiple barriers to employment

**What:** part-time work-based training

**Where:** in local public or non-profit agencies or community organizations

**Why:** providing older Americans with opportunities for unsubsidized employment



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Program Highlights



- Assessments and Individual Employment Plans (IEPs)
- Community Service Work-Based Training
- Coordination with Workforce Systems



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Eligible Applicants



- Organizations **capable** of operating in more than one state
  - ❑ Non-profit organizations
  - ❑ Federal public agencies
  - ❑ Tribal organizations
  
- Separate awards for Indian and Asian Pacific Islander non-profit organizations



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Funding



- Total available Federal funds: approximately \$341,000,000
- Approximately 47,500 authorized positions @ \$7,153 each
- Federal funds = 90% of grant budget
- 1 year award + 2 option years



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Minimum Funding Requirement



In each state, applicants must apply for **whichever is greater:**

- \$1.6 million or
- Minimum of 10% of national funds in **the state** (applies in California, Florida, Pennsylvania, New York, and Texas)



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Rules for Choosing Positions



- Meet applicable minimums for each state (i.e., \$1.6 million or 10% of national funds in the state)
- Apply for all national positions in a county
- Serve contiguous counties if multiple counties needed to meet minimums



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Exceptions to Position Rules



For all applicants—

- Options for 12 counties with positions over funding minimums:
  - Apply for the entire county
  - Apply for a portion of the county
  - Add contiguous counties if needed to meet funding minimum

For Asian Pacific Islander and Indian Applicants ONLY—

- Counties do not have to be contiguous
- Must take all positions within a county and meet state funding minimums



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Grant Reporting Requirements



## Performance

- Collect and report all required data elements via high-speed Internet
- Use SCSEP Performance and Results QPR system (SPARQ) unless grantee demonstrates a system that adequately uploads (exports) data



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Grant Reporting Requirements



## Financial

- Submit quarterly reports electronically
- All financial reporting on an accrual basis



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Proposal Requirements



## Technical Proposal

- Narrative** (not to exceed 45 pages)
- Required Attachments**
- Appendix K** (Positions Bid Form, submitted electronically)

## Cost Proposal

- SF 424** (Application for Federal Assistance)
- DUNS Number**
- SF 424A** (Budget Information Form)
- Break out by cost category**
- Transition costs**

# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Evaluation Criteria/Scoring



## Design and Governance 15 points

- strategic planning, service design, program integration*

## Program & Grant Mgt Systems 10 points

- admin controls, personnel, non-Federal share, procurement, reporting systems*

## Financial Management System 10 points

- budget controls, internal controls*

## Program Service Delivery 40 points

- e.g., recruitment, eligibility, IEPs, community service training, host agency issues, unsubsidized employment*

## Performance Accountability 25 points

- performance management*

**Maximum = 100 points**



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Application Review Process



- Review panels meet after May 26
- Review panels submit recommendations based on:
  - Rated criteria scores
  - Panel scores
  - Comments on evaluation criteria
  - Comments on proposal
- Ranked scores: primary basis for selection



# SCSEP SGA PY 2006 Submission of Applications



- **Deadline:**  
Received by May 26  
(or postmarked not later than May 21)
- Applicants are encouraged to apply on-line at [www.grants.gov](http://www.grants.gov)
  - Get started now
  - Registration process required
  - Recommend submitting prior to deadline
