- Page J-1 - Item J-8, amend to “Utah & Montana”;
- Page L-4 - Item L6, section A, 1st line and list of proposal sections, amend to “Proposals submitted in response to this RFP shall consist of the following sections, each separately bound:

- Page L-6, Item L6, section B, sub-section 1g, amend to “The 600 page limitation applies.....”;
- Page L-9, Just before 5.- Insert “**4. Subcontracting (Does not apply to Certified Small Businesses) (original and 2 copies):**

Submit a subcontracting plan in accordance with Clause 52.219-09. The plan must separately address subcontracting with 1) small business, 2) small disadvantaged business, and 3) women-owned small business concerns, and 4) HUB Zone small business concerns. For purposes of this procurement, the SIC Code is 8999. Offerors are considered small businesses if their annual sales or receipts for the preceding 3 years do not exceed \$5 million.

Proposed subcontracting of key components must be described in detail including organizational relationships and procedures established to ensure proper management, oversight, training, etc. A complete breakdown of costs associated with the subcontracting of a key component of center operations must be displayed in the Business Management Proposal. This should also include any costs associated with oversight of the sub-contractual relationship.

Your plan will be evaluated in terms of quality, conformance with regulatory requirements, and corporate efforts/commitment. The Office of Job Corps seeks to provide incentives for offerors to subcontract major portions of operations with 1) small business, 2) small disadvantaged business, 3) women-owned small business, and 4) Hub Zone small business concerns. Therefore, up to five points may be awarded where the proposed subcontracting involves key operational components”;
