1. In the Outreach and Admissions services in the state of Texas, the contractor ensures the arrival of a minimum of 592 students into the Job Corps program annually. Does this number include the students enrolled at the Roswell JCC? If so, what is the break down?

Yes, this number will include students enrolled at the Roswell JCC. Applicants will be recruited from the geographic areas and counties served by the following local Workforce Development Areas:

Upper Rio Grande and Permian Basin Workforce Development Areas of Texas and the Eastern and Southwestern Workforce Development Areas of New Mexico.

2. Will recruitment happen in the states of Texas and New Mexico?

Yes, recruitment will occur in New Mexico (See question # 1).

3. Currently we are recruiting in the Midland/Odessa areas (Permian Basin Workforce Development Area) of the state of Texas. However, this area has not been designated as a recruitment area for us. Is it possible to have the Permian Basin Workforce Development area designated as an OA/CTS service area for the DL Carrasco JCC?

Yes (See number 1 & 4). In addition, the latest GAP update will reflect the Permian Basin Workforce Development Area as a designated OA/CTS service area for DL Carrasco.

The contractor shall provide or arrange for post-center career transition services for eligible students enrolled at the DL Carrasco JCC and the Roswell JCC. Contractor will provide Career Transition Services for the following: **390 youth returning to the Upper Rio Grande Workforce Development Area of Texas and 105 youth returning to the Permian Basin Workforce Development Area of Texas and the Eastern and Southwestern Workforce Areas of New Mexico.**
