1. Page 3 of the proposal states that, "The Contractor shall provide Post-Center Career Transition Services annually for 731 youth returning to the state of California." Page 14 states that, "For purposes of this procurement the contractor should anticipate an annual inflow of new students for provision of career transition services in the numbers shown below. These are the anticipated numbers of new graduates and new former enrollees who will be assigned to the contractor each year: 674 Graduates; 226 Former enrollees." The latter totals 900 (674 plus 226) and appears to contradict the earlier reference to the contractor's requirement of providing Post-Center Career Transition services to 731 youth. Can this be clarified?

Response: In developing proposals, offerors should rely on the information contained in page 14, wherein it states that Post-Center Career Transition Services is applicable to this contract and that the anticipated number of youth for which the offeror shall provide these services is 674 new graduates and 226 former enrollees.

2. Does the forty (40) "ACT" training slots referred to in the table on page 12 include off-center training slots?

Response: No. The 40 slots are reserved for ACT, or Advanced Career Training. ACT is the component of the program by which trainees can participate in advanced career training through enrollment in post-secondary institutions. This particular contract provides for only 30 OCT slots in the Computer Service Technician vocation.

3. Page 124 states that, "For purposes of the RFP, the inflationary rate used in projecting costs shall be the same inflationary factor that is reflected in the Congressional Job Corps appropriation for the budget or program year in which the option year begins. The amounts proposed in the option years are therefore considered provisional." What is the actual inflationary factor that you would expect bidders to use in determining the costs for the contract's out-years?

Response: An inflationary factor of 2.1% should be used when figuring cost estimates for the out-years.

4. Is the Guajome Park Academy Agreement with the Job Corps available to bidders?
