1. *Is there a revised due date for the submission of proposals?*

Yes. The revised date by which proposals responding to this RFP must be provided to the San Francisco Regional Office is September 6, 2002. The proposals still must be submitted to our office by 5:00 p.m. Pacific Daylight Time.

2. *Under the contract, should invoices be submitted for payment monthly or bi-monthly?*

Invoices, or "vouchers", should be submitted for payment on a bi-monthly basis, that is, twice a month.

3. *Can the bidders obtain a list of current OA offices throughout California operated by the current operator and information concerning which leases can be assumed under their terms?*

4. *Page 37 discusses that Service Contract Act Wage determinations apply to this contract. Will the bidders be provided with this information?*

The Service Contract Act Wage determinations vary between different parts of California and sometimes between neighboring counties. Thus, there is no one wage determination applicable to the entire state. After the contract has been awarded, the contract will be modified to include the various pertinent wage determinations when the need arises.

5. *Is the Office of the Job Corps expecting the successful awardee to use the new format for the ETA 2110 (the monthly financial data sheet) or the old format of the ETA 2110?*

We expect the entity to which the contract is awarded to use the newer, revised format of the ETA 2110. (See the RFP, at page J-4.)

6. *Must the name of the key personnel be revealed in the proposal?*

While we understand the need for confidentiality, it is very important that the name of the key staff be clearly stated in proposals. This factor is considered when we are scoring proposals. However, the offerors should know that the information submitted to the Job Corps in this process is considered proprietary and thus confidential. The information is not revealed externally.

7. *Will a property list of furniture and equipment be made available?*

8. *Is there a "geographic assigned plan", or "GAP", for this contract?*

This office does not utilize such a term. However, and as the RFP discusses, 85% of the potential trainees recruited are expected to attend the center geographically closest to her residence of record. There is also a component of the contract which would require the successful bidder to "export" trainees to the Sierra Nevada Job Corps Center in Reno, Nevada, the Clearfield Job Corps Center in Utah, and the Seattle Region Job Corps centers.

9. *Is there an estimated date of the award of the contract?*

The award likely will be announced a few days prior to the March 1, 2003 deadline.

10. *Is there a time by which any remaining questions must be submitted?*

All remaining questions must be submitted **in writing** to the Contracting Officer. The last day by which this office will consider written questions is Tuesday, August 6, 2002, 5:00 p.m. local time (PDT). This office may post a second amendment to the RFP if written questions are received.

11. *(1) Is the Automated Past Effectiveness Report used to determine performance points for current contractors developed from the same data-base from which the OAOMS-10 report is generated? (2) If there are errors on the OAOMS-10 report will it affect the total points awarded for existing contractors? (3) Is there anyone we should contact if errors are suspected?*

(1) Yes, performance points are obtained from the most current OA report for past effectiveness. (2) Yes, if errors occur on the Automated Past Effectiveness Report, it will have a negative impact on your points.
