Why We Need 1512s

(Statute)

Section 1512 of the Recovery Act requires reporting to inform the public on how funds are expended at the local level.



Terms and requirements differ from what is required under other grant programs.



Why We Need 1512s

(Practically Speaking)

Promotes transparency in government funding



Provides the public, media, Congress, and Administration timely data on the progress of the grant

Data is:

- Collected
- Posted for review on Federalreporting.gov
- Reviewed
- Posted on Recovery.gov for everyone to see





1512 Factoids

- ❑ Data is collected per calendar quarter
- ❑ Reporting Period: 1st through 10th day of the following quarter
- ❑ No data is entered in the Infrastructure Contact section because ARRA funds are not allowed for “brick and mortar”-type projects or awarded to individuals
- ❑ Expenditures & Drawdowns are reported **cumulatively**.
- ❑ *The Number of Jobs is reported per quarter*
- ❑ Collecting data on sub-recipient and vendor expenditures is used to support the Administration’s interest in how funds are being used
