

In addition, the meeting will also provide a forum to discuss the claims control operation of the Federal Claims Control Center (FCCC) and various FCCC upgrades and changes, including:

- UCX issues related to obtaining wage and separation information from the FCCC; and
- Claim Control Records.

Funds are available to assist with the cost of travel for state IPCs and ICON programmers to attend the meeting. To obtain these travel funds, state agencies must submit a written request containing the travel cost estimates (including itemized costs for air fare, hotel, per diem, ground transportation and registration fee). States do not have to submit supplemental budget requests to obtain these funds. Funds are limited to travel costs for the IPC and ICON programmer.

3. Action Required: State Workforce Agency Administrators are requested to:

- a) Share this information with appropriate members of your agency's staff;
- b) provide travel cost estimates for your agency's Interstate Program Coordinator and ICON programmer and submit the information to Kesha Rodriguez, rodriguez.kesha@dol.gov and/or Timothy Martin, martin.timothy@dol.gov, by June 23, 2004 to allow for a timely distribution of the funds; and
- c) Provide the names and job titles for your agency's participants to Kesha Rodriguez, rodriguez.kesha@dol.gov and/or Timothy Martin, martin.timothy@dol.gov by July 30, 2004.
