

2-Year RN Student Application/Selection Process

Two-part Application Process for 2-year RN degree through Bridging Distances project:

- Application and acceptance into the partner school's nursing program
 - School application
 - Nursing program application
 - Basic Skills assessment
 - Nursing aptitude assessment (if offered)

The nursing aptitude assessment and the basic skills assessment will be scheduled locally. You will be notified of the date and location. Application should be submitted to the school – see information in your packet.

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- Application and selection for the Bridging Distances program:
 - Southwest Minnesota Private Industry Council Application
 - Nursing Self-Assessment (for 2-year RN)
 - Distance Learning assessment (website on back of self-assessment)
 - Provide two letters of reference, at least one of which should be from a healthcare facility supervisor or equivalent person
 - Provide transcripts of education completed
