INTRODUCTION

The Directory of Santa Cruz County Workforce Service Providers is one component of the Tri-County Community Asset Investment Portfolio being developed by Social Policy Research Associates (SPR) for the three counties of Santa Cruz, Monterey, and San Benito. The Directory is part of an assessment of workforce programs and providers in these counties and is designed to allow Workforce Investment Board members and staff to better understand the programs available in their communities. In addition to this Directory, the Tri-County Community Asset Investment Portfolio will eventually also include an assessment of workforce needs, an inventory of available workforce services, an evaluation of any gaps in workforce services and, finally, recommendations on how the counties might address these service gaps.

The Directory is based on data collected from a web survey of workforce service providers carried out from August 15 to October 11, 2002. The survey was designed to collect information on workforce programs in the Tri-County Region both for this Directory and the Inventory of Services Interim Report. 130 Tri-County providers out of a total of 323 (response rate 40.25%) responded to the survey and provided information about 92 programs that serve Santa Cruz County.

The providers surveyed were primarily organizations with programs that offer workforce services for youth, adults and employers such as vocational training, job search assistance, career counseling, pre-screening of job applicants, and summer employment. Many providers of support services such as child care, substance abuse treatment, and housing were also included.

Because the Directory includes only those organizations who responded to the survey, please note that the information and programs presented represent a only self-selected sample of all the service providers in the county rather than a complete listing.
