BACKGROUND: The occupation Medicaid Disability Claims Adjudicator was submitted by Elisa Gallegos, on behalf of the New Mexico Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (NM DVR).

This occupation clearly lends itself to the structured On-the-Job Learning and Related Technical Instruction of Registered Apprenticeship. A Medicaid Disability Claims Adjudicator conducts complete case examinations, adjudicates claims for governmental social insurance program benefits, obtains and evaluates medical evidence, and researches and interprets complex regulations, among other high skill tasks.
