PURPOSE: To inform the Office of Apprenticeship (OA) staff of a revision of an existing occupation to include a Career Lattice for:

Chief Cook (Water Transportation)
 RAIS Code: 1053CB
 O*NET-SOC Code: 35-9011.00
 Training Term: 1,000 - 2,080
 Type of Training: Competency-based

BACKGROUND: This revision for the occupation of Chief Cook (Water Transportation) was submitted by The Paul Hall Center for Maritime Training and Education was approved by the OA Administrator on August 17, 2006.

This bulletin establishes a Chief Cook (Water Transportation) Career Lattice with three competency-based Certificate of Training program career paths leading to the Chief Cook (Water Transportation) registered apprenticeship program. The Chief Cook (Water Transportation) is in high demand in the Water Transportation Industry, particularly in the Cruise Ship Hospitality Industry. The Chief Cook (Water Transportation) occupation has been recognized as an apprenticeable occupation to meet the Water Transportation Industry demands for a highly skilled, highly trained Chief Cooks

To meet the industry demands, this occupation consists of training in the following levels of competency:

Dining Room Steward Utility	1053A	1,000	Certificate of Training
Bar Assistant Utility	1053B	1,000	Certificate of Training

Upon completion of the Dining Room Steward Utility, Bar Assistant Utility or the Galley Cook Utility programs, the apprentice will be eligible for a "Certificate of Training" and upgrading to the registered apprenticeship Chief Cook (Water Transportation) program. After completion of the Chief Cook (Water Transportation) registered apprenticeship, the apprentice will be eligible for a "Certificate of Completion of Apprenticeship."

ACTION: OA staff should familiarize themselves with the attached bulletin. A copy of the Work Processes Schedule and Related Instruction Outlines are attached for your review.
