BACKGROUND: The occupation Energy Auditor and Analyst was submitted by Apprenticeship and Training Representative (ATR) Dick Overton, on behalf of the Building Science Academy, LLC.

The Energy Auditor and Analyst (Existing Homes) conducts energy audits and develops work scope for residential energy audits. These energy audits are conducted using diagnostic testing tools and safety testing, such as via blower door, infrared camera, combustion safety testing, and duct leakage testing.

This occupation clearly lends itself to the structured on-the-job learning and Related Technical Instruction of Registered Apprenticeship.
