PURPOSE: To inform the staff of OA and the State Apprenticeship Agencies (SAA), Registered Apprenticeship program sponsors and other Registered Apprenticeship partners that the International Pipe Trades Joint Training Committee (IPT-JTC) has approved the addition of the following new Technical Training Institutions. These institutions allow graduates of these schools direct entry into the HVAC Industry Apprenticeship Programs sponsored by IPT-JTC with at least one year of credit.
