BACKGROUND: Mr. Jason Wilson, Iowa Brewers Guild, submitted a Request for Apprenticeability Determination for the occupation Professional Brewer. It was approved by the OA Administrator on February 12, 2016. A Professional Brewer is a technician responsible for all duties related to beer making, including sourcing ingredients, recipe formulation, sanitation, wort production, fermentation, filtration, packaging, equipment maintenance, and quality control, as well as staff supervision and regulatory compliance.

Professional Brewer will be added to the List of Occupations Recognized as Apprenticeable by OA when the list is reissued. A suggested Work Process Schedule and Related Instruction Outlines are attached.

ACTION: OA staff should familiarize themselves with this bulletin and the attached Work Process Schedule and Related Instruction Outline, as a source for developing apprenticeship standards and/or providing technical assistance.
