PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Dannon Project will develop a Birmingham Reentry Center to coordinate comprehensive case management services that include assessment, referral, linkages, training, education, job placement, and follow-up services for returning offenders. The program will be designed to meet the needs of previously incarcerated individuals who participated in pre-release services at Alabama Correction Facilities and who have been referred from the Alabama Board of Pardons and Parole. Post-release services for one year will be provided to 100 participants. Services will be provided at the Birmingham Health Care main office and healthcare complex forming a Birmingham Reentry Center with holistic and comprehensive services for returning prisoners and their families.
