

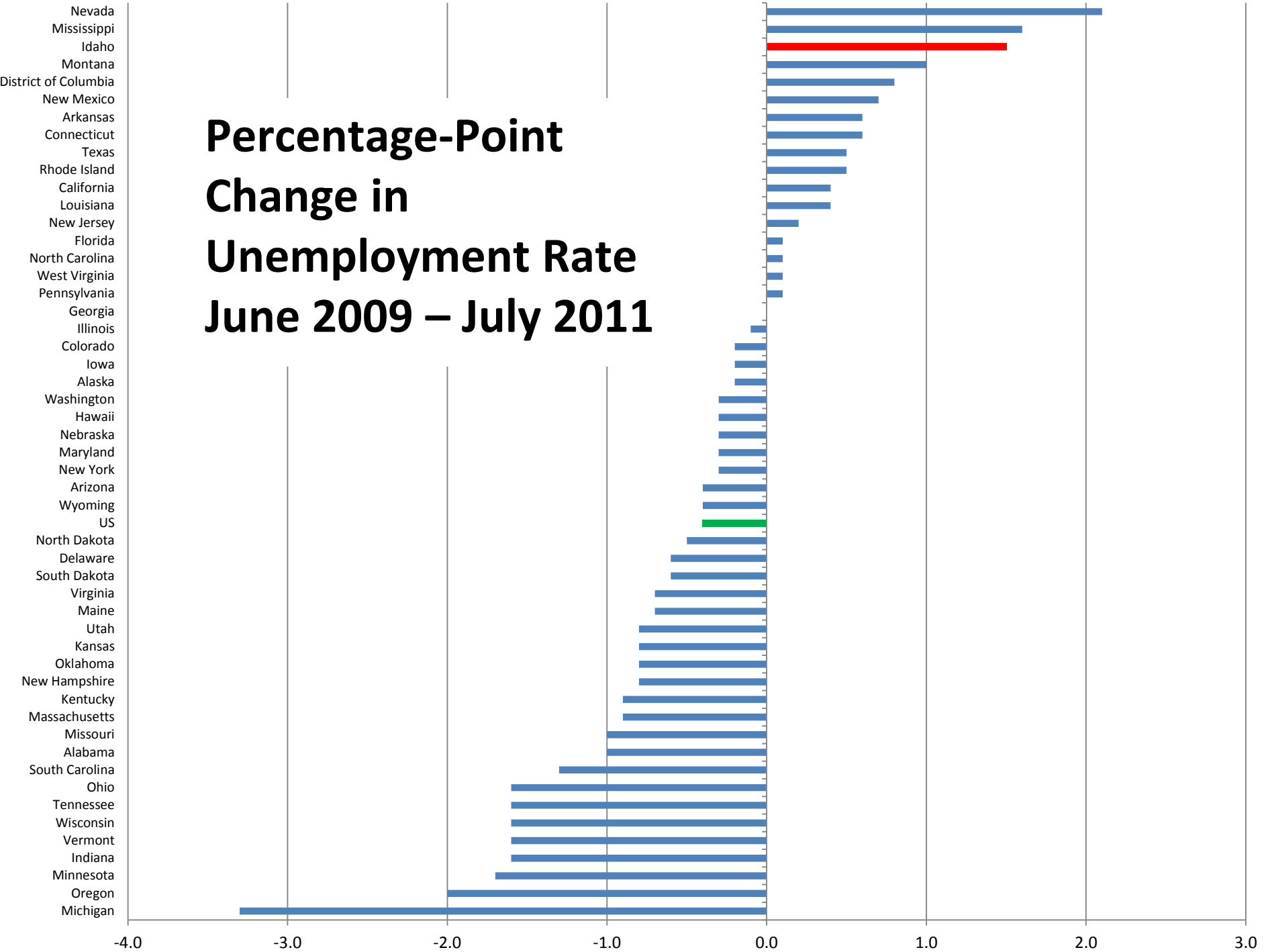


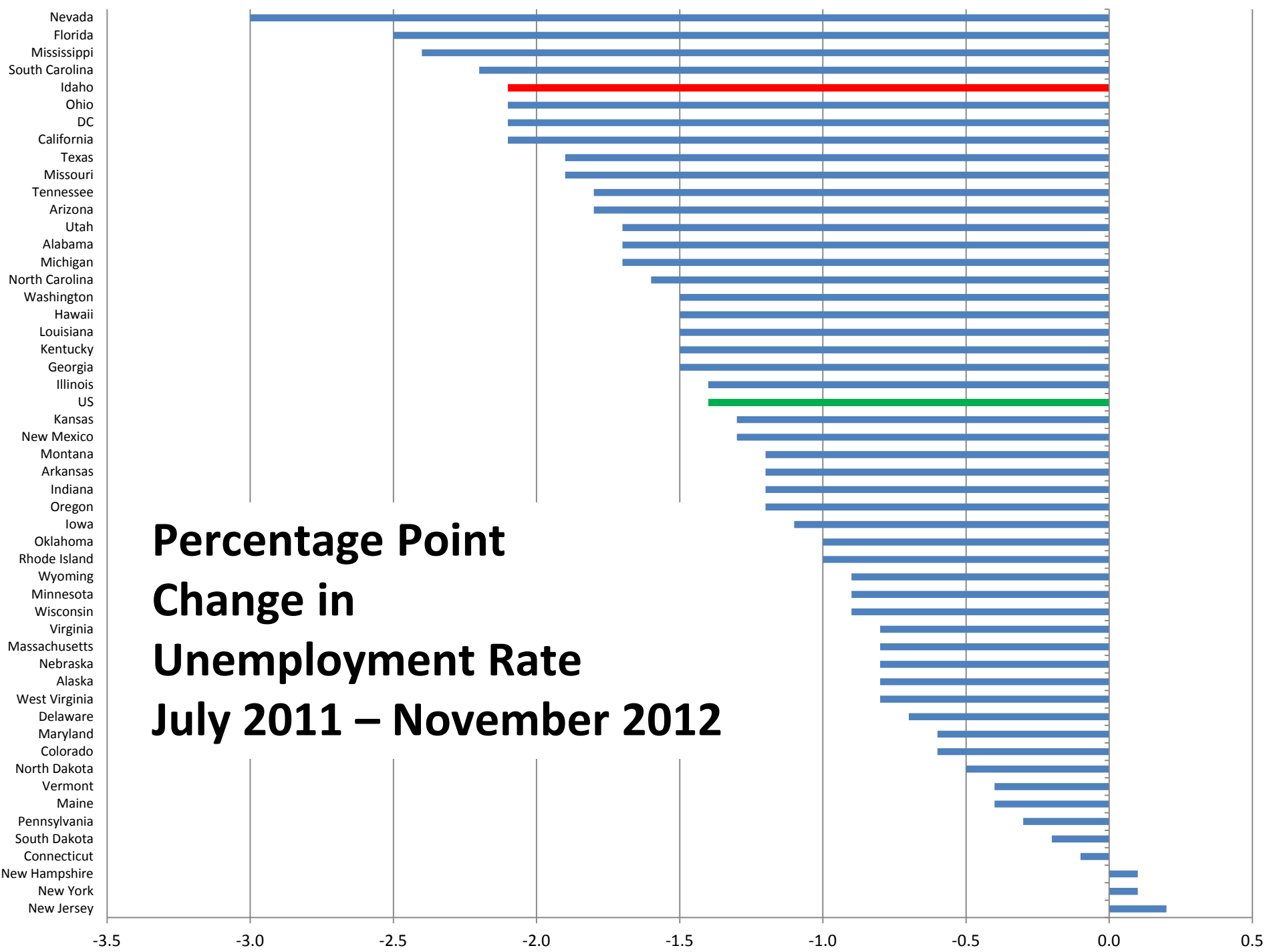

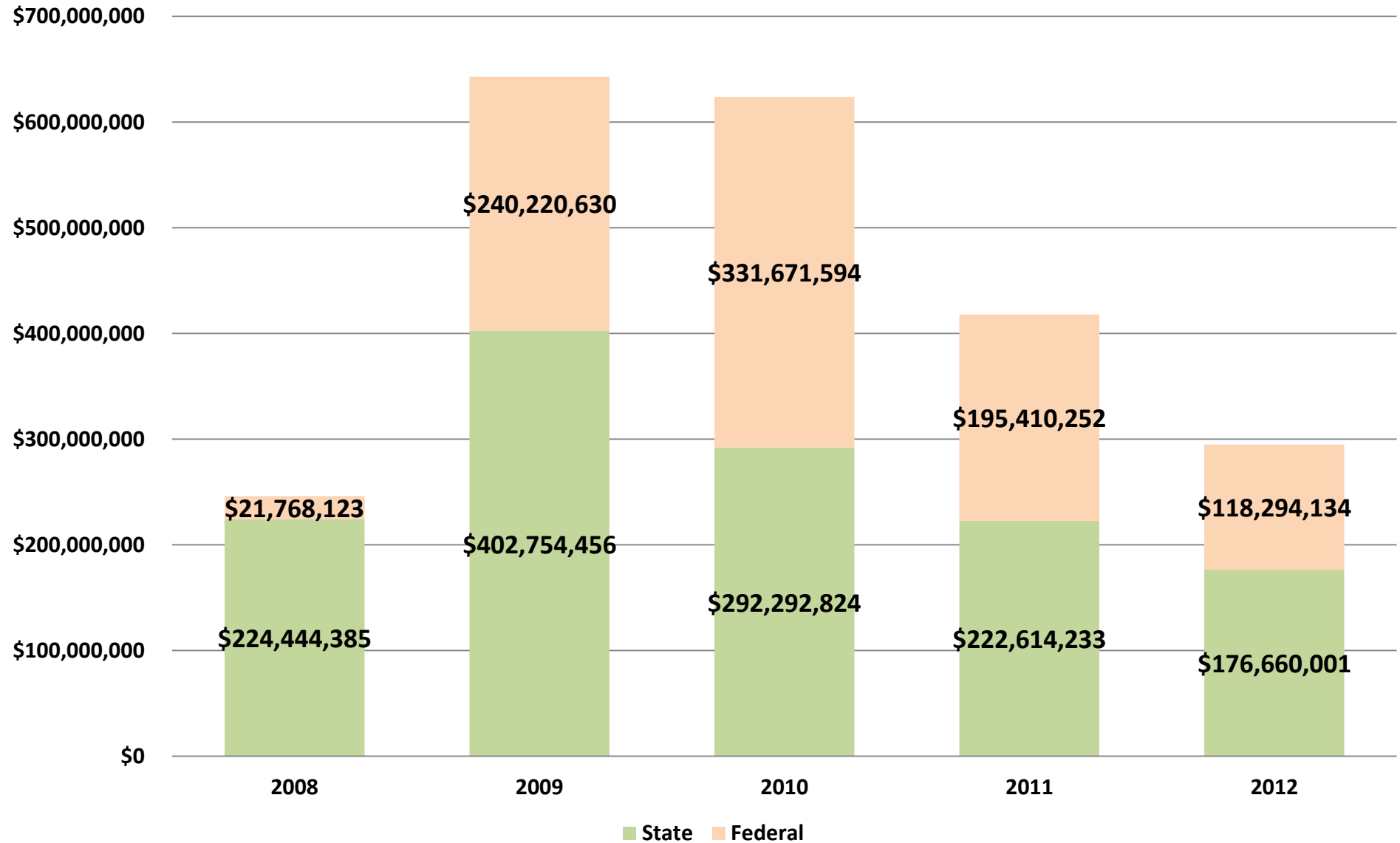

Percentage-Point Change in Unemployment Rate June 2009 – July 2011





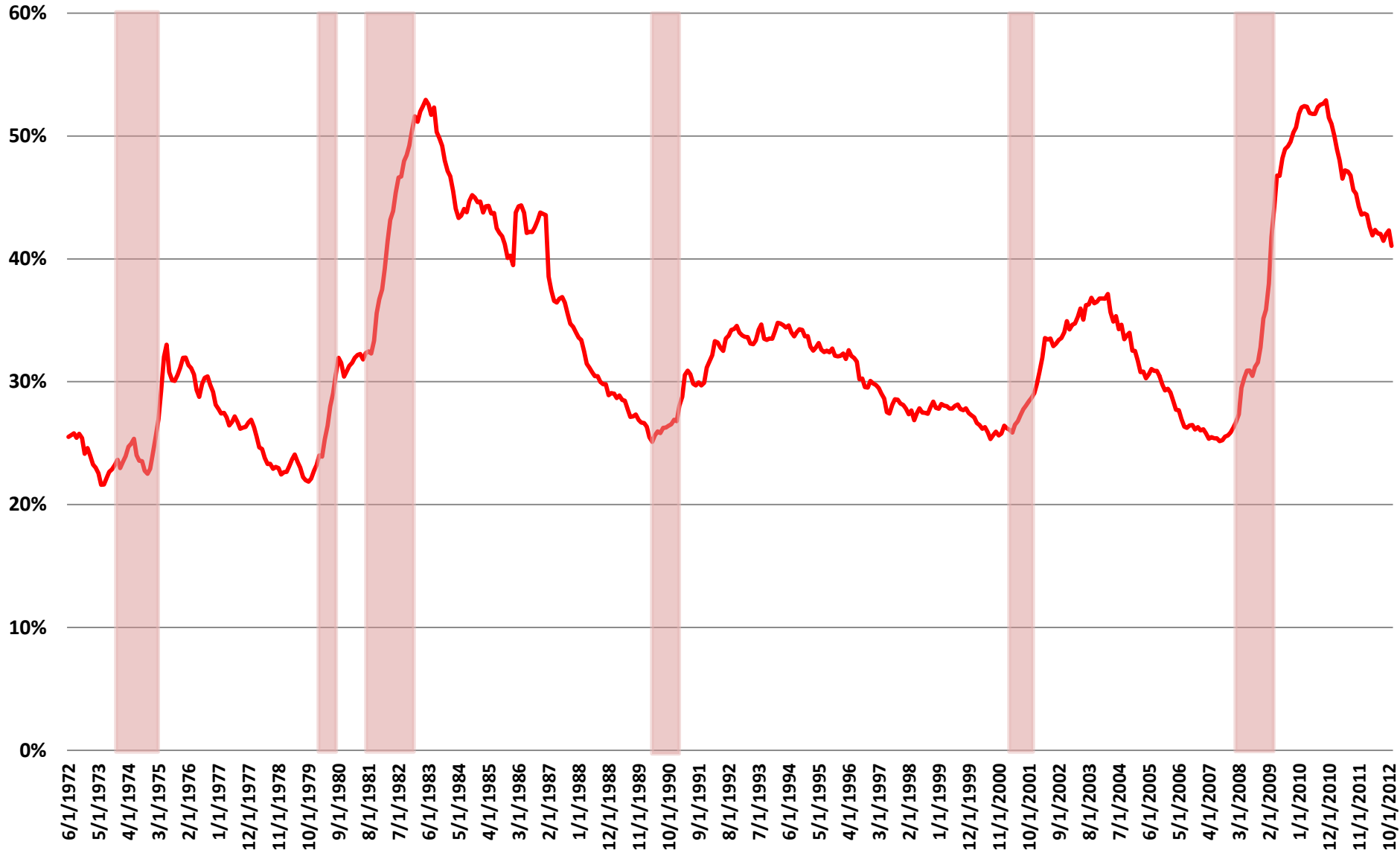
Idaho Unemployment Insurance Benefits



Individual Workers Receiving Jobless Benefits

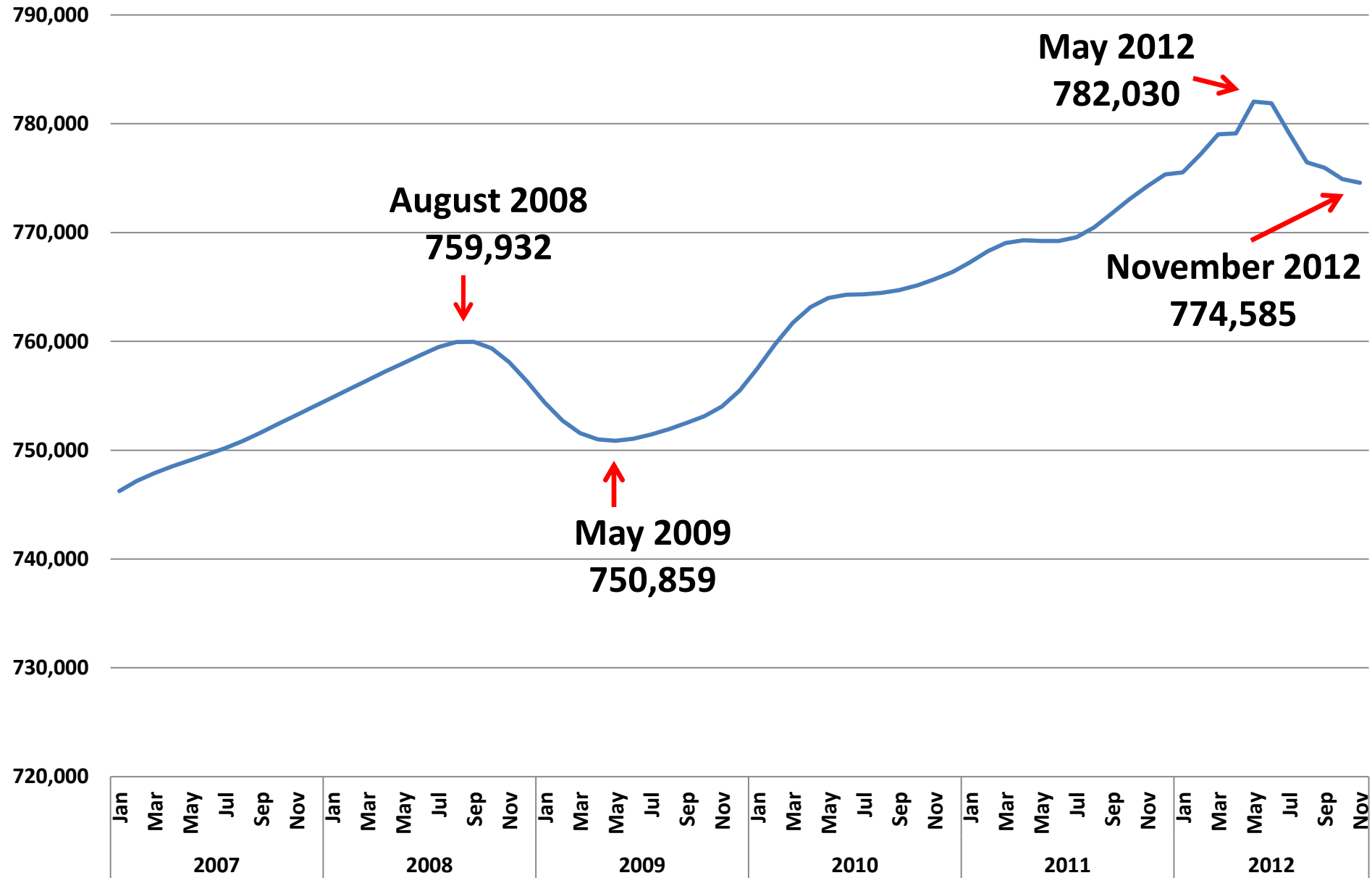


Idaho Exhaustion Rate 1972-2012

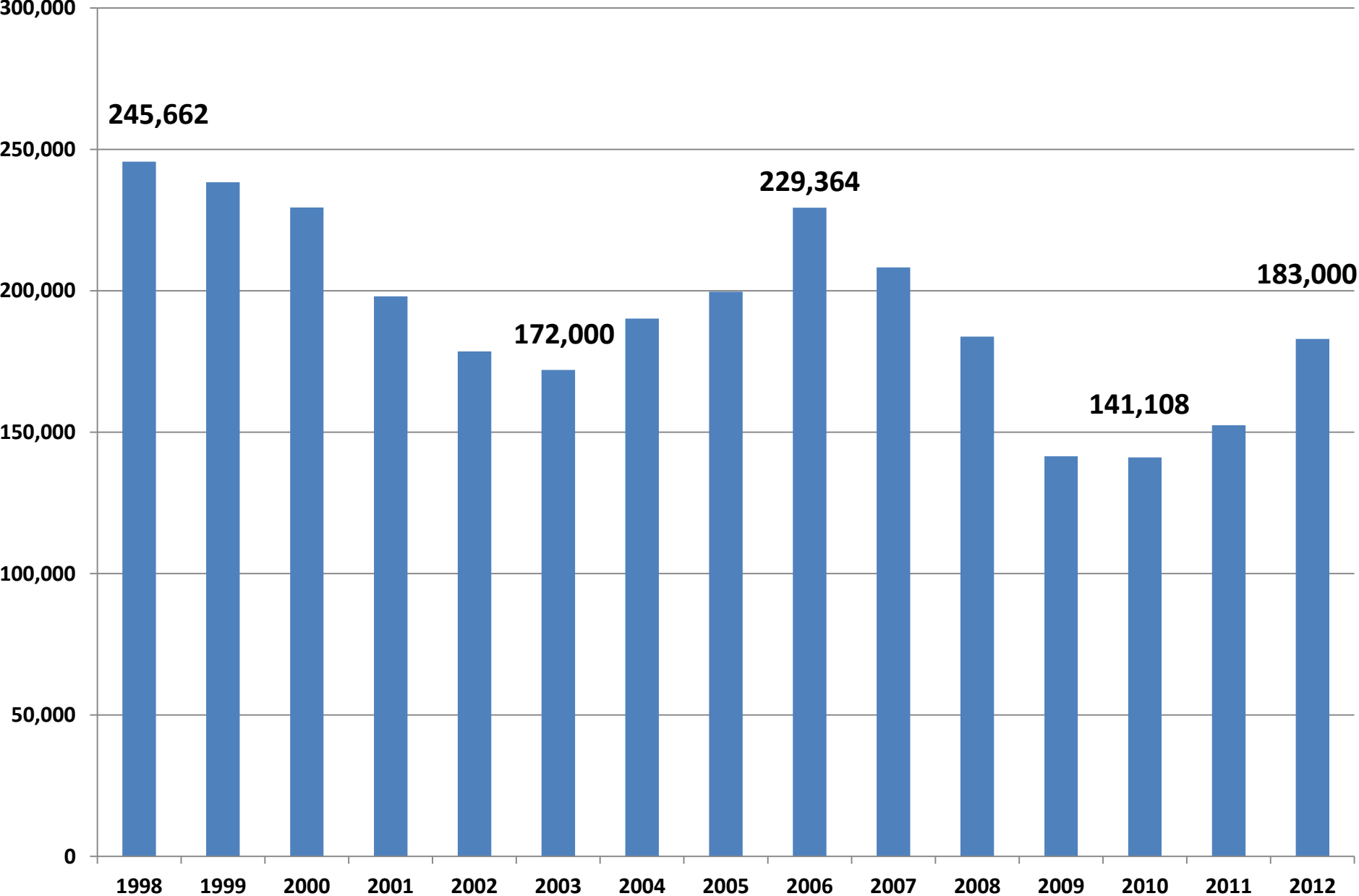


Idaho's Monthly Labor Force

Seasonally Adjusted



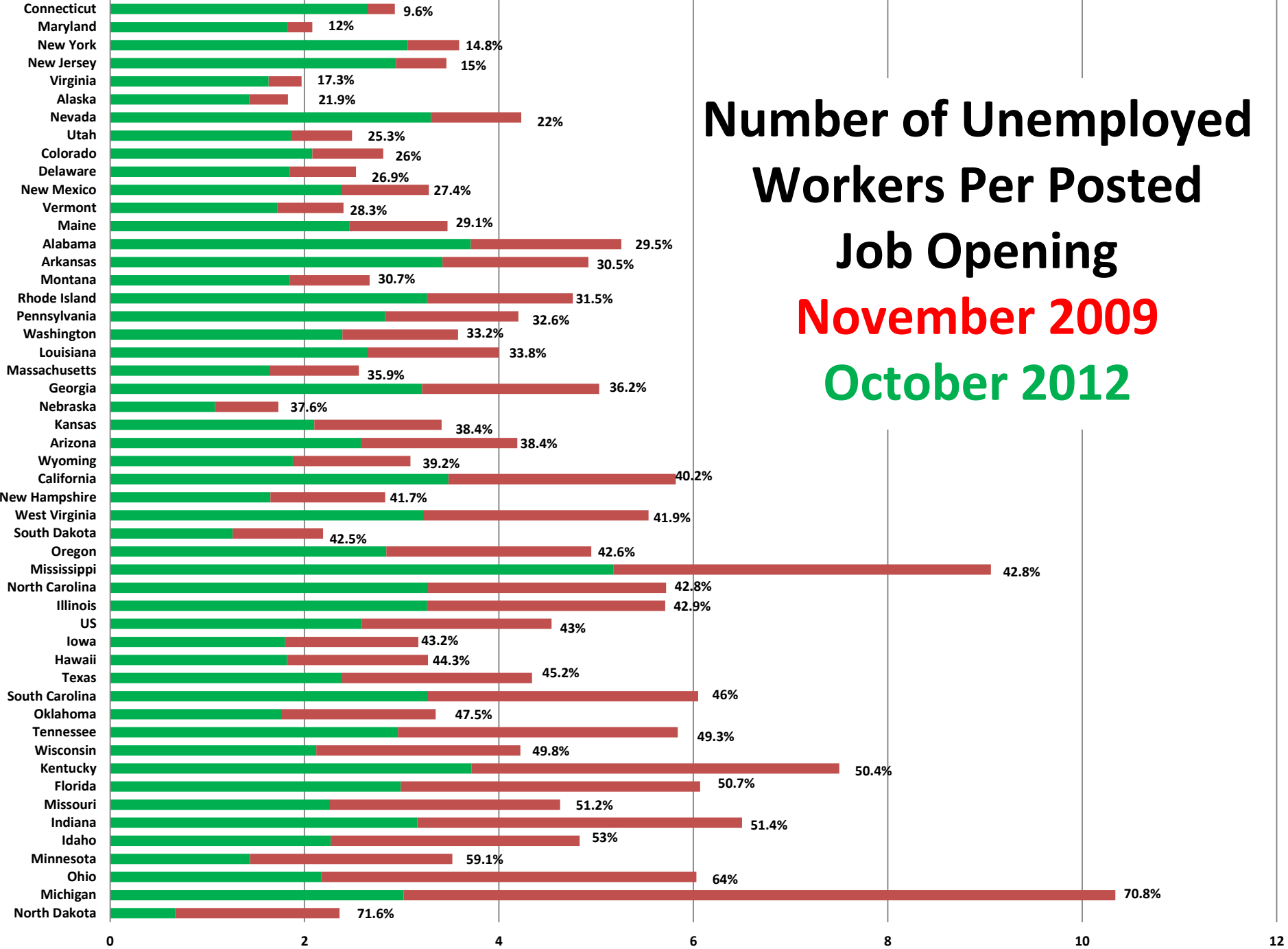

Number of Unemployed Workers Per Posted Job Opening

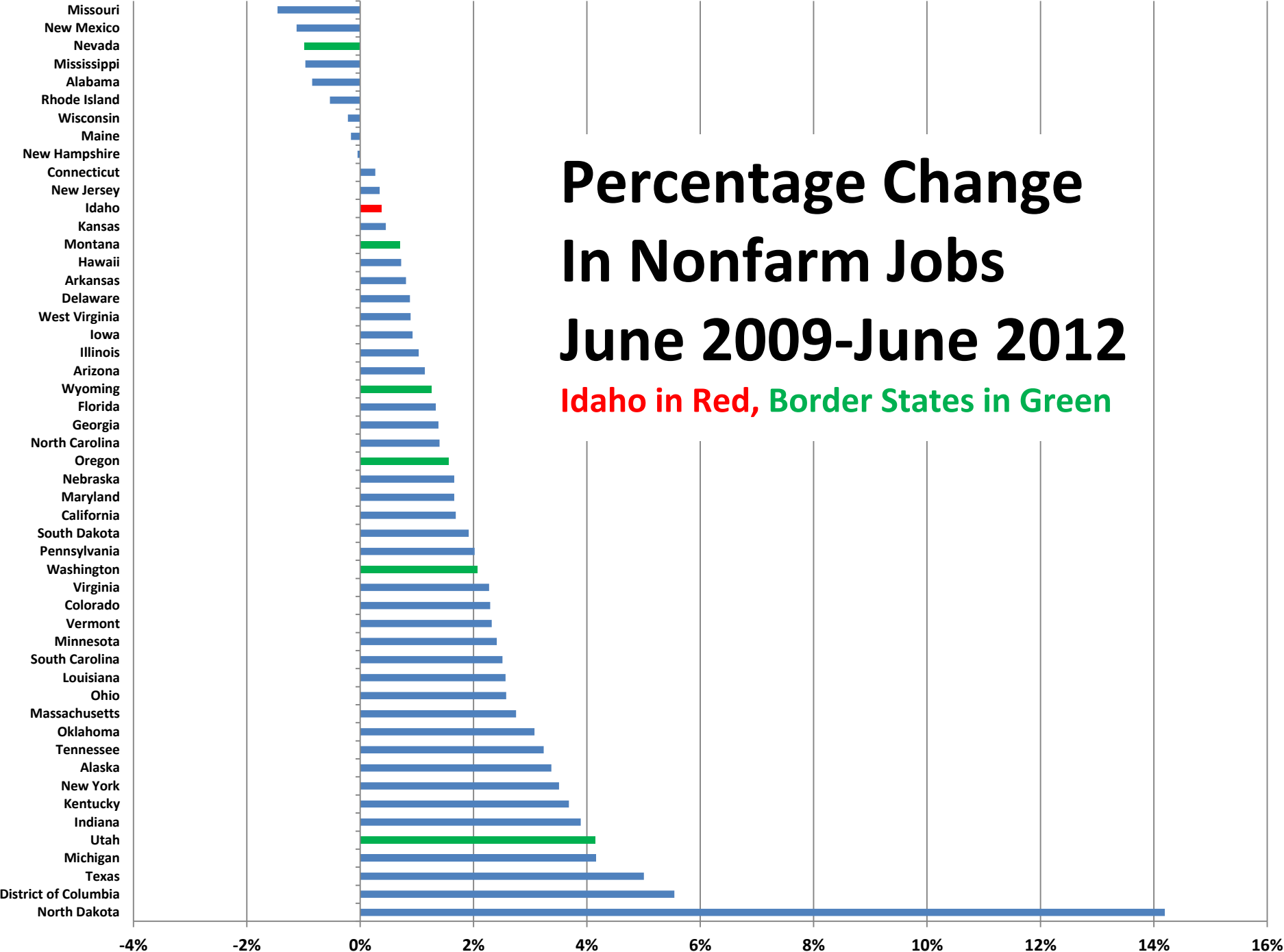

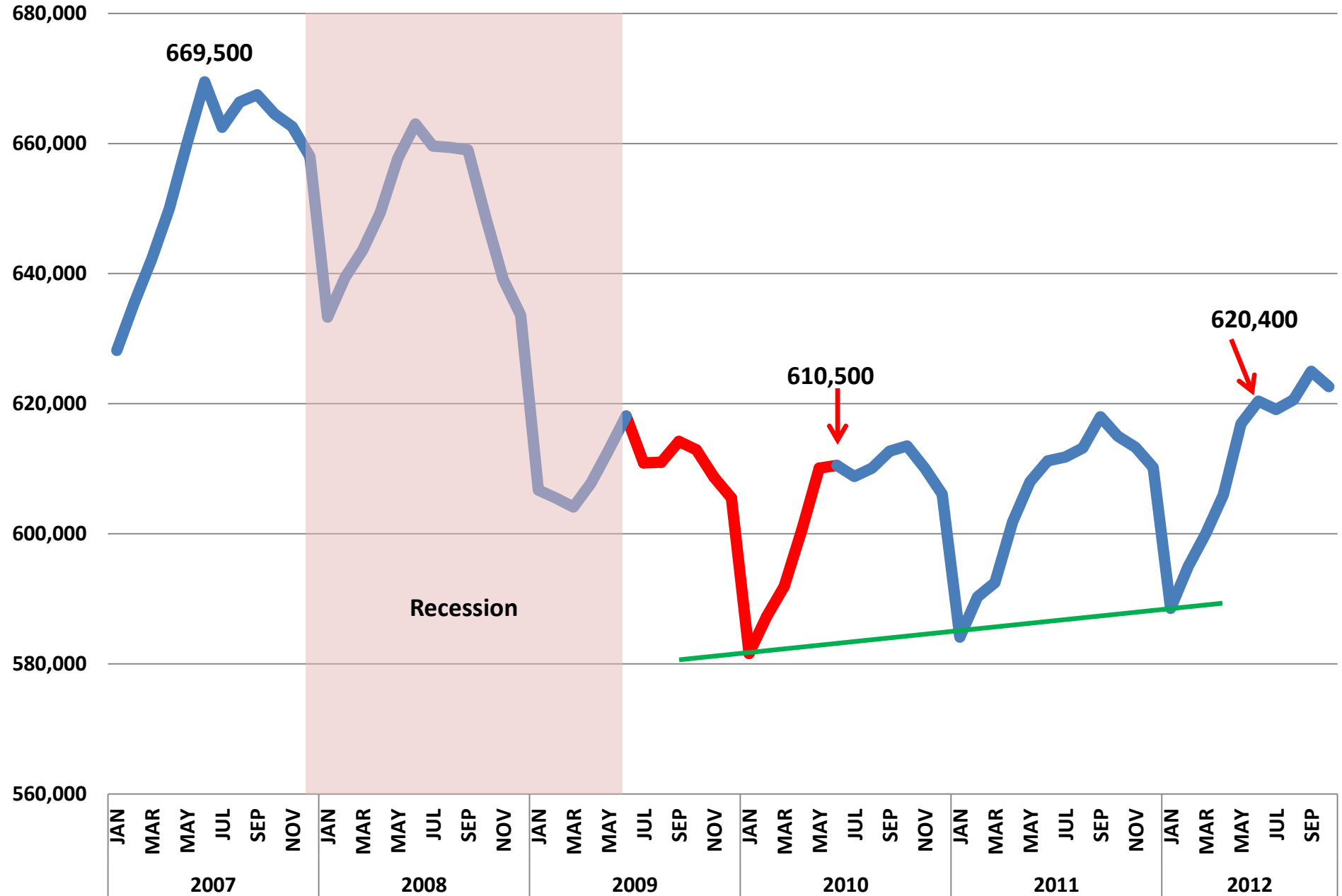


Percentage Change In Nonfarm Jobs June 2009-June 2012

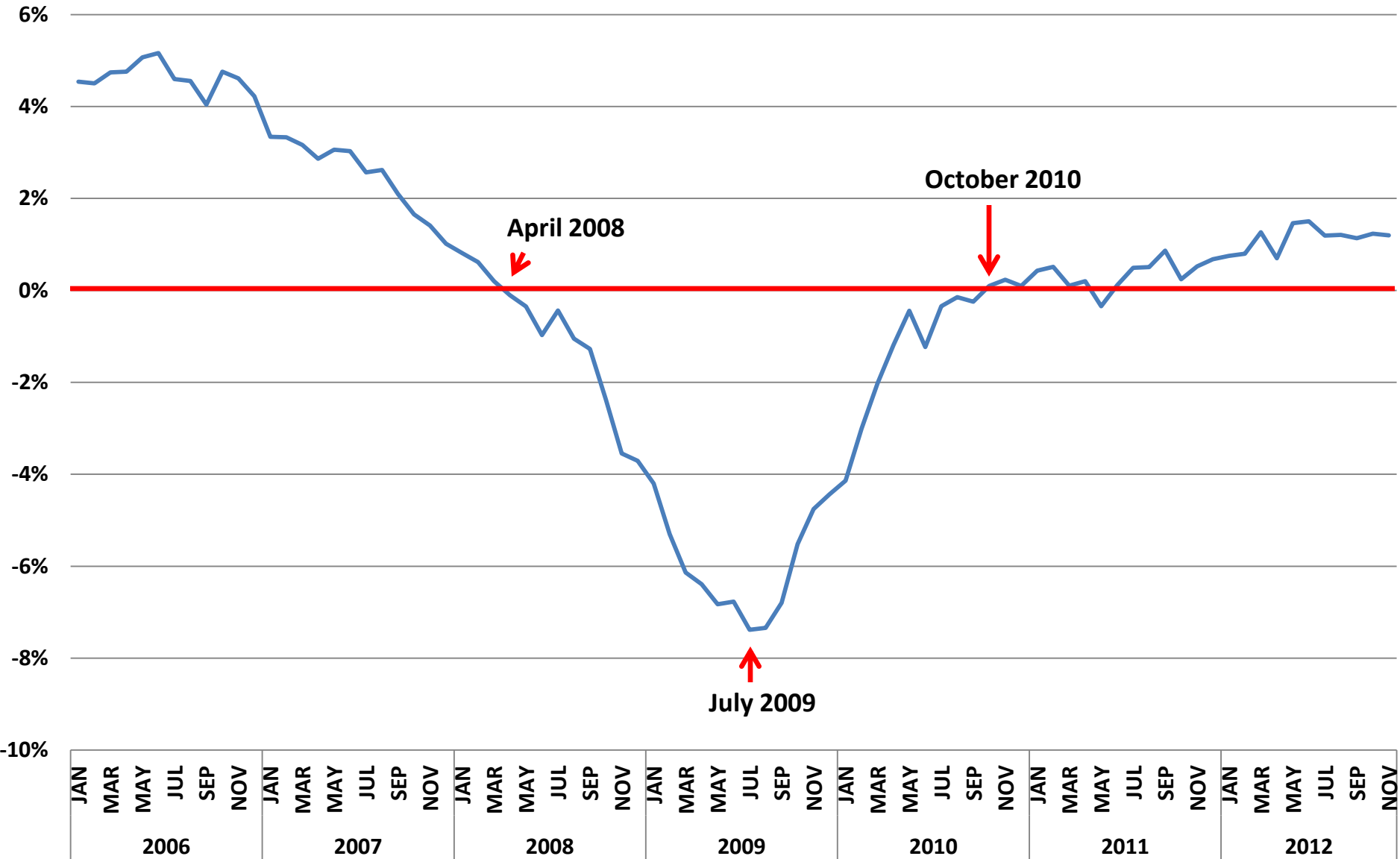
Idaho in Red, Border States in Green



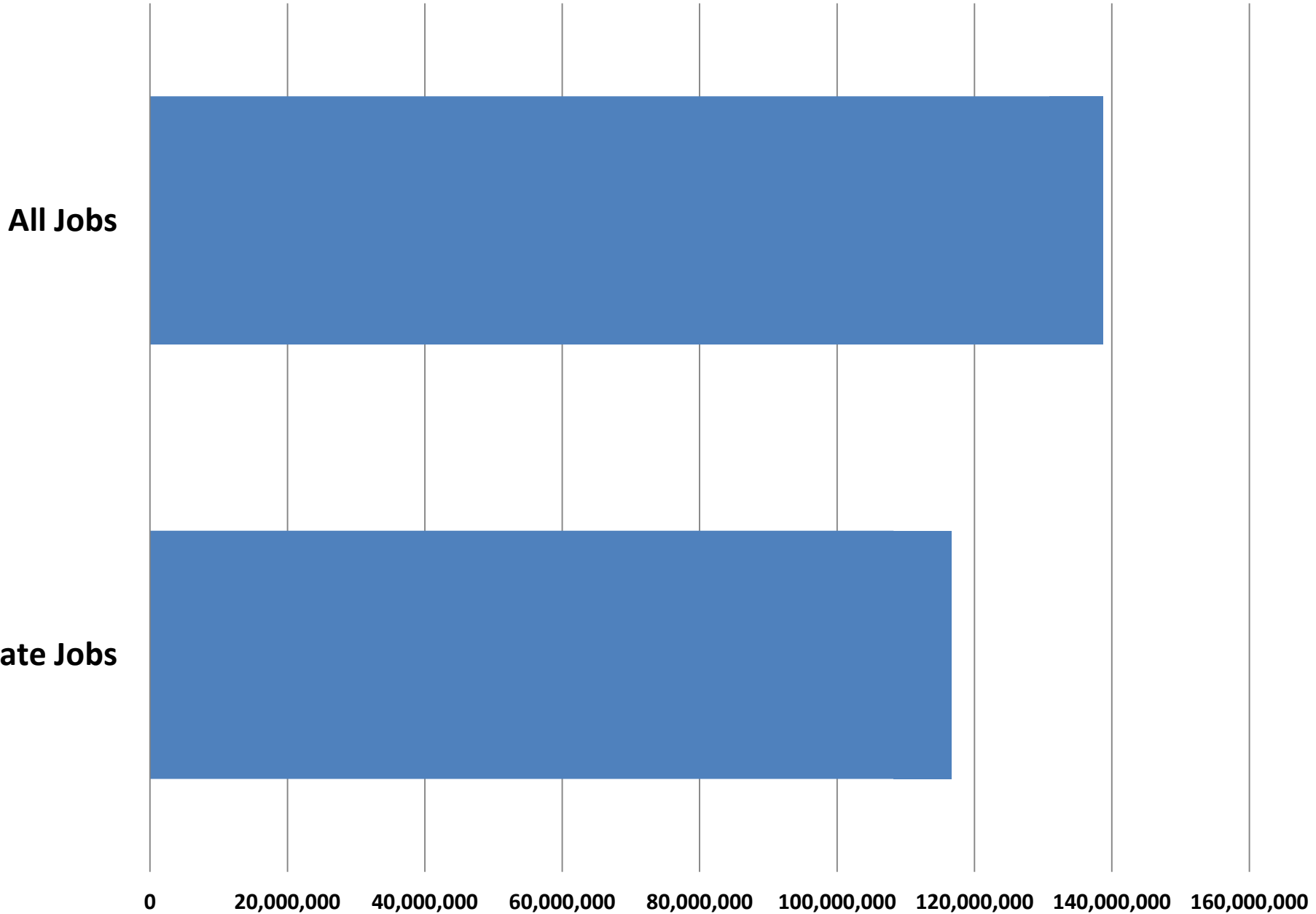
Monthly Idaho Nonfarm Jobs



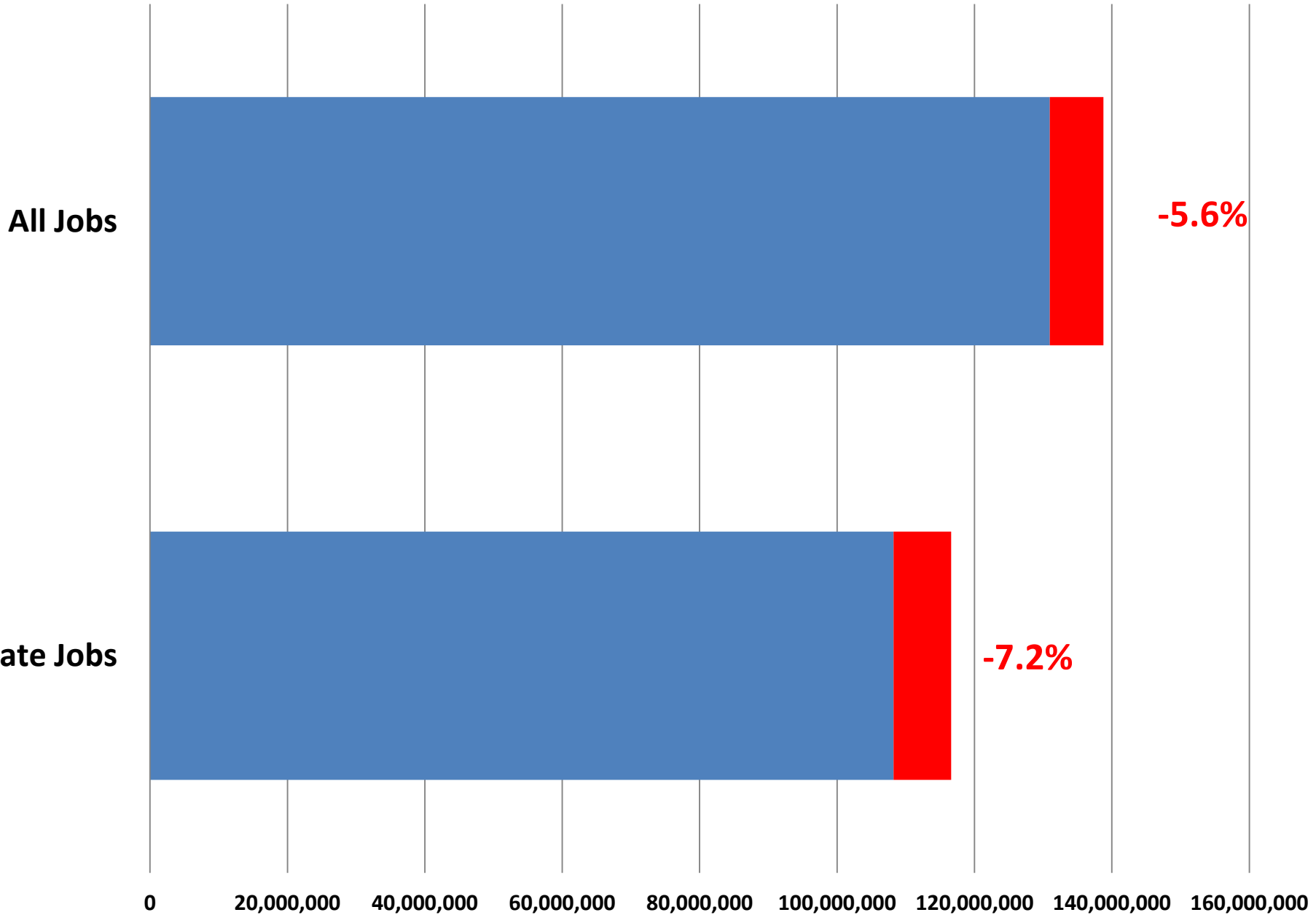
Year-Over-Year Percentage Change in Idaho Nonfarm Jobs



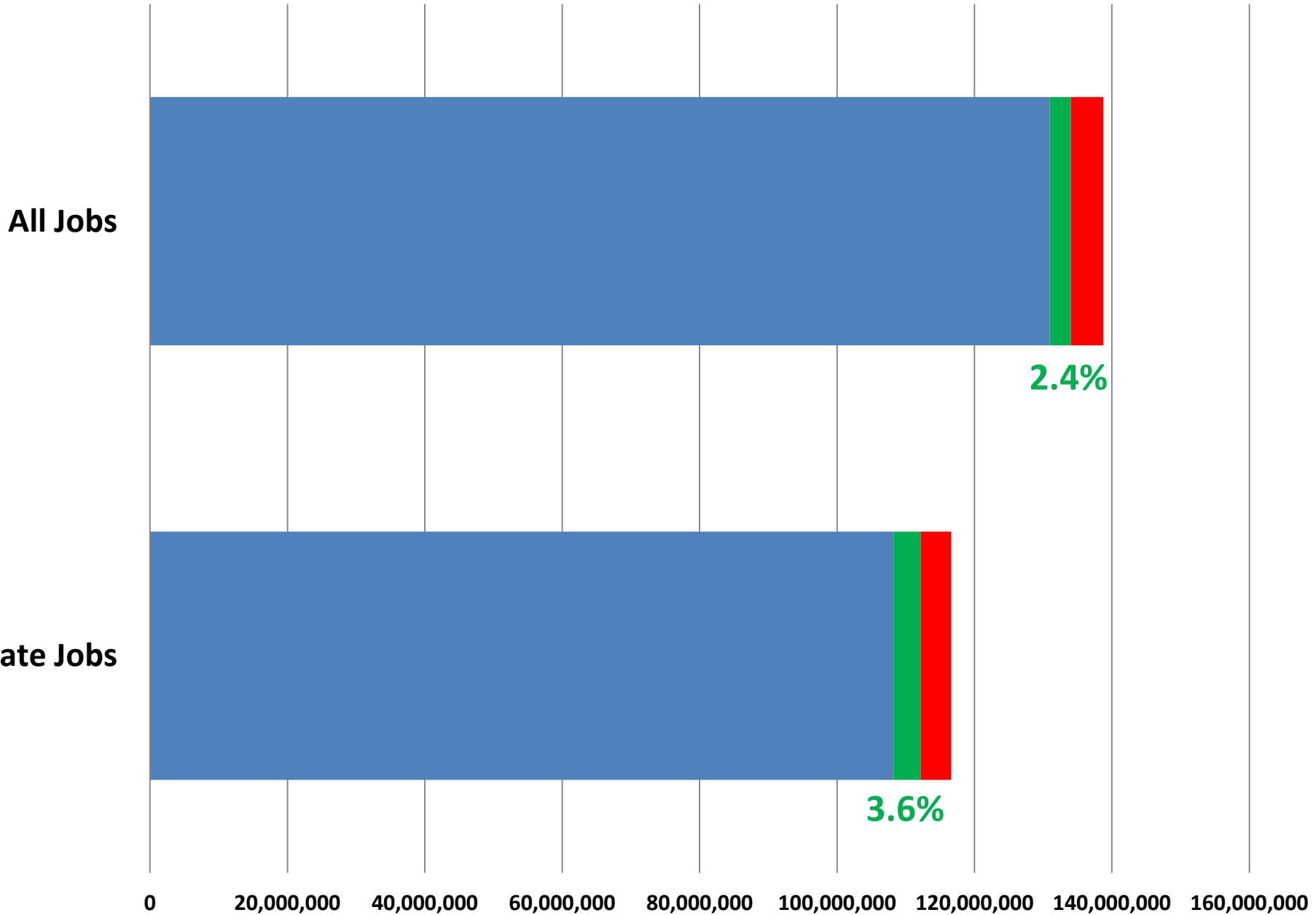

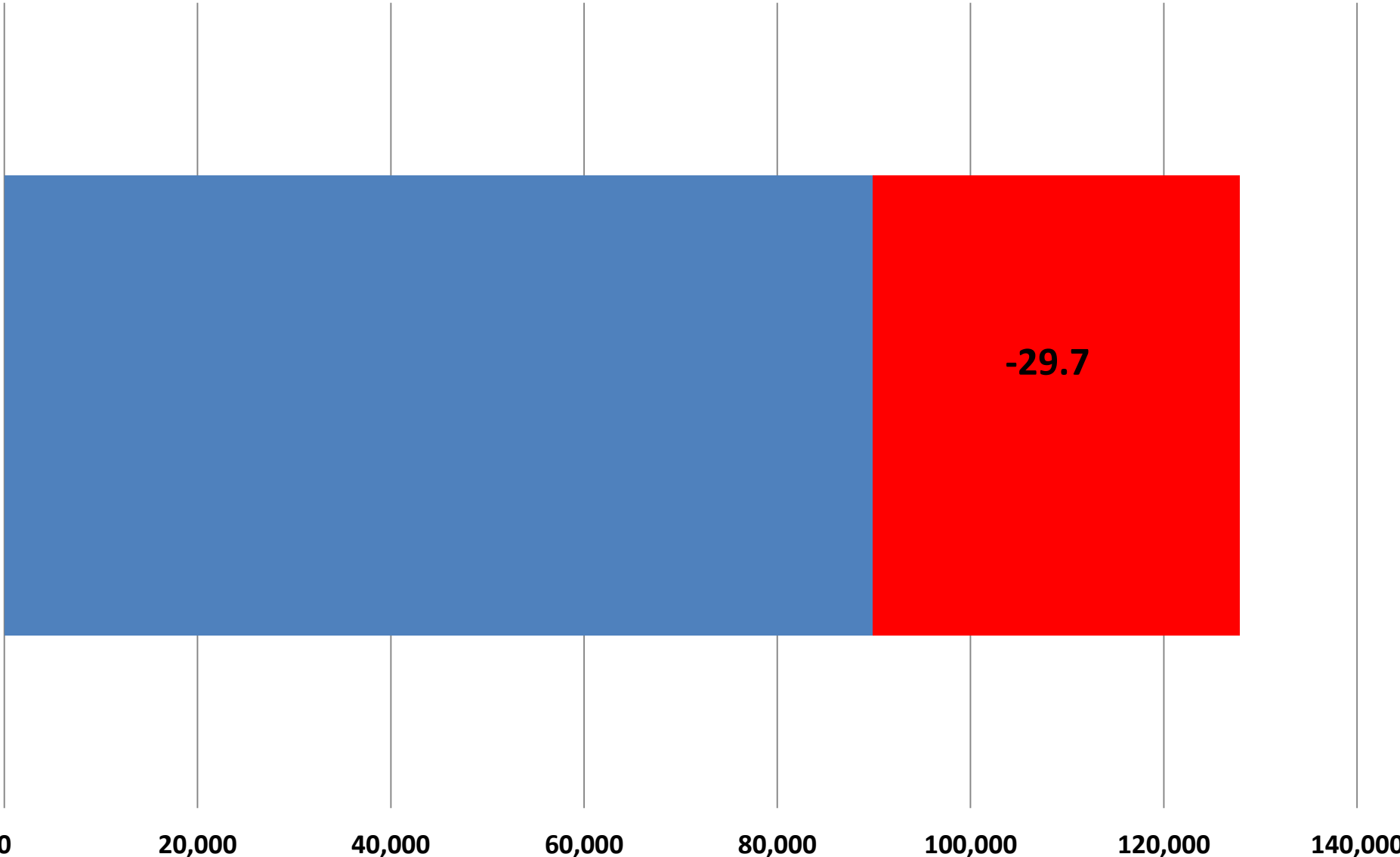

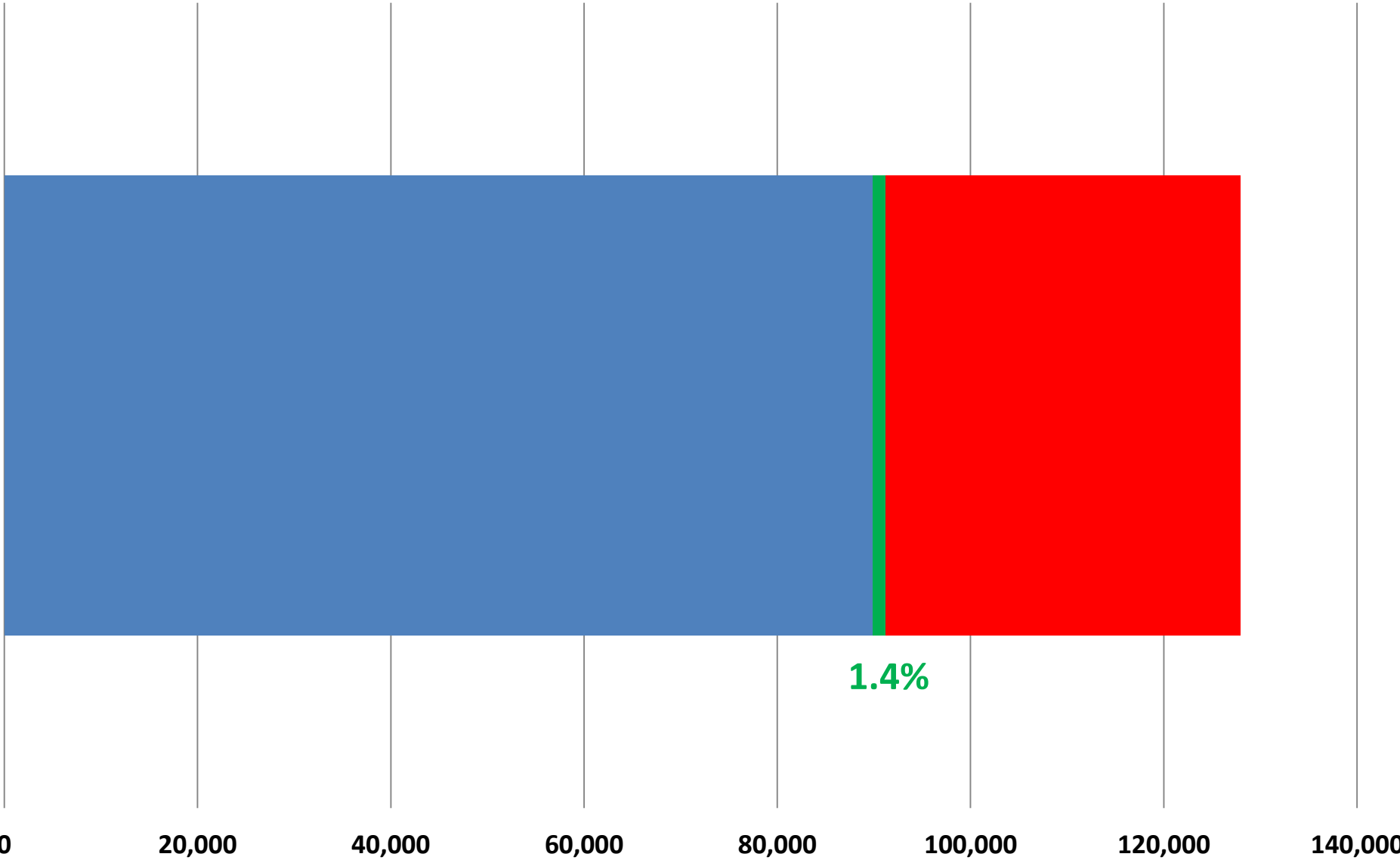
Idaho Goods Producing Sector June 2007



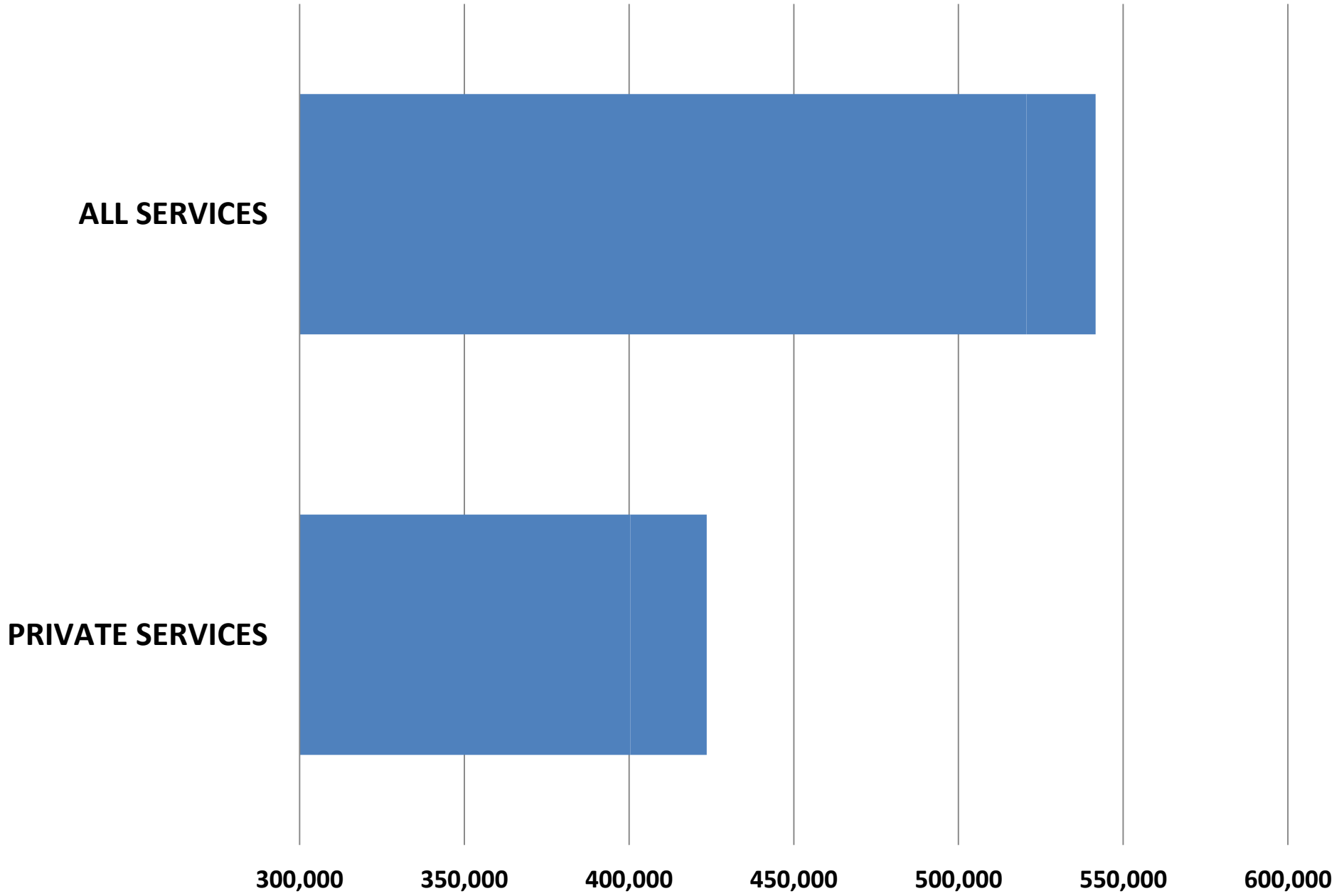

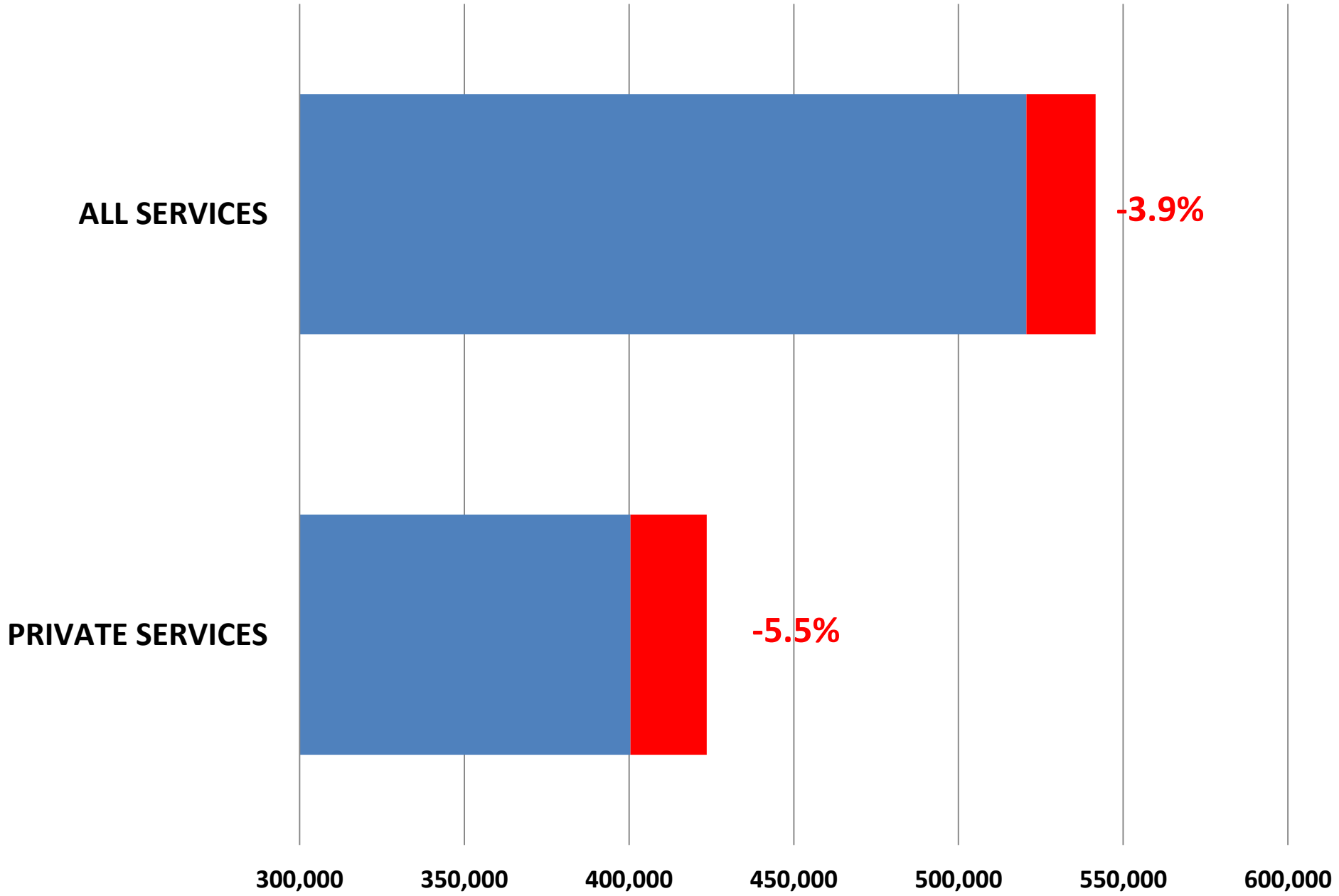

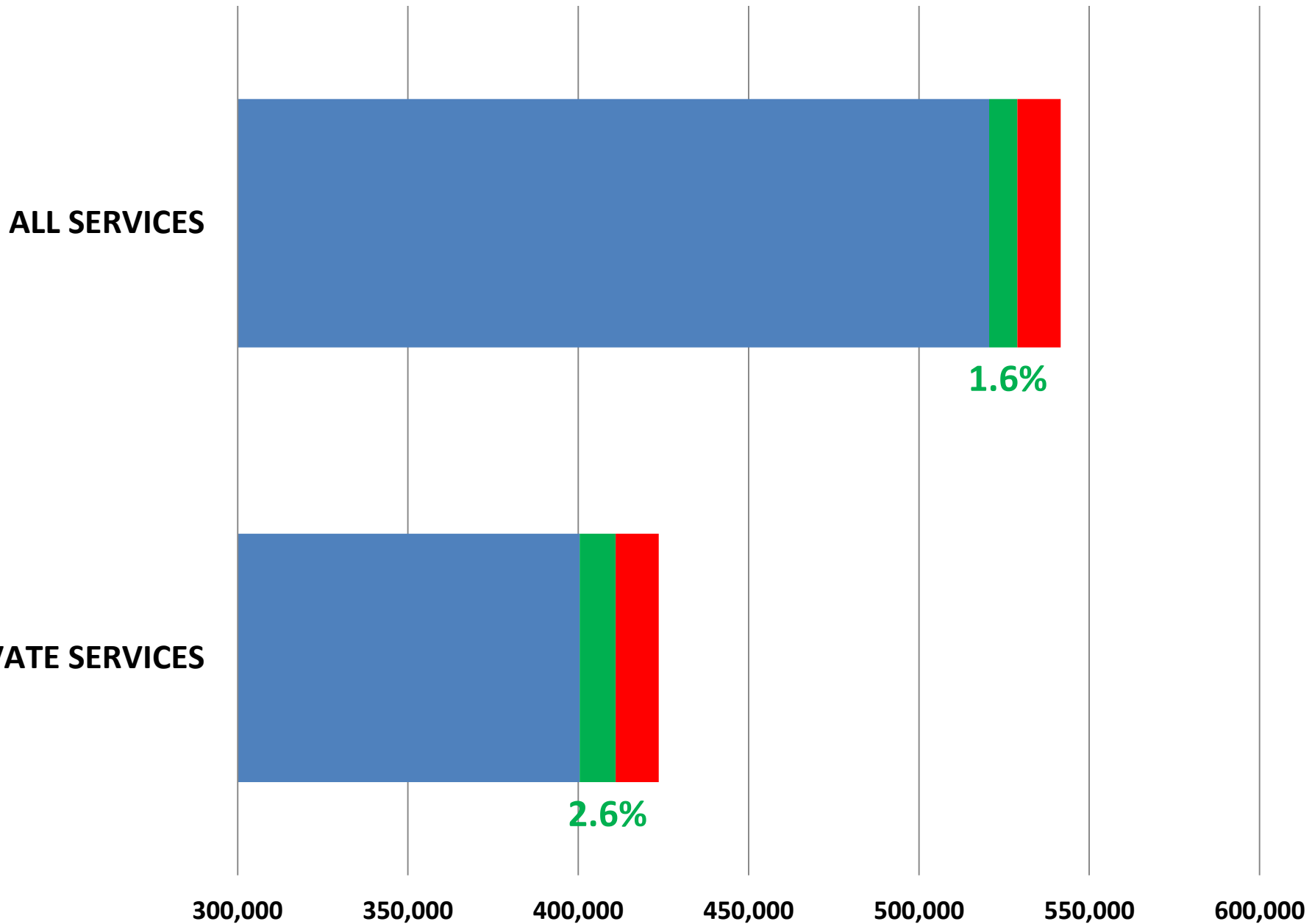

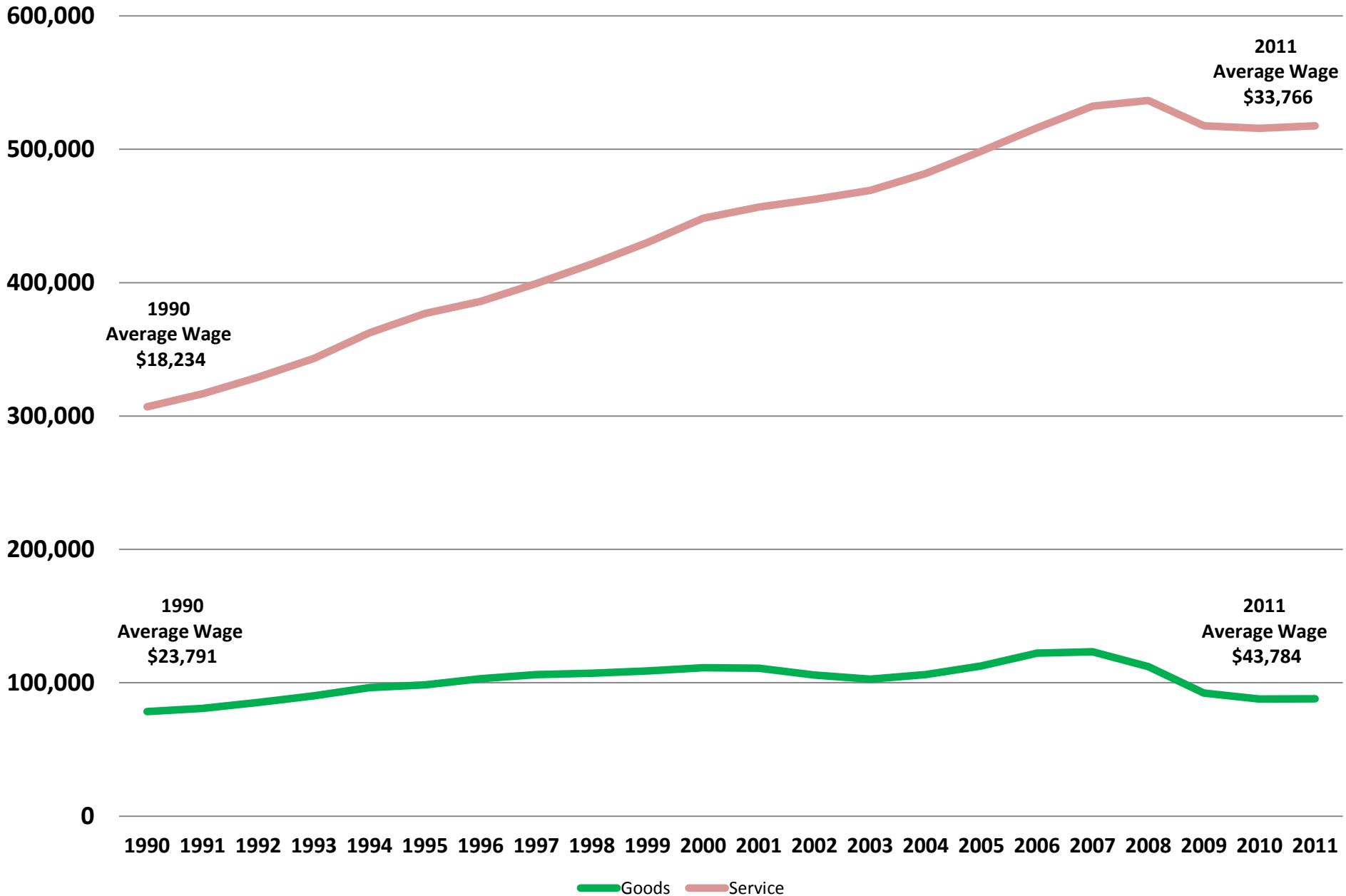

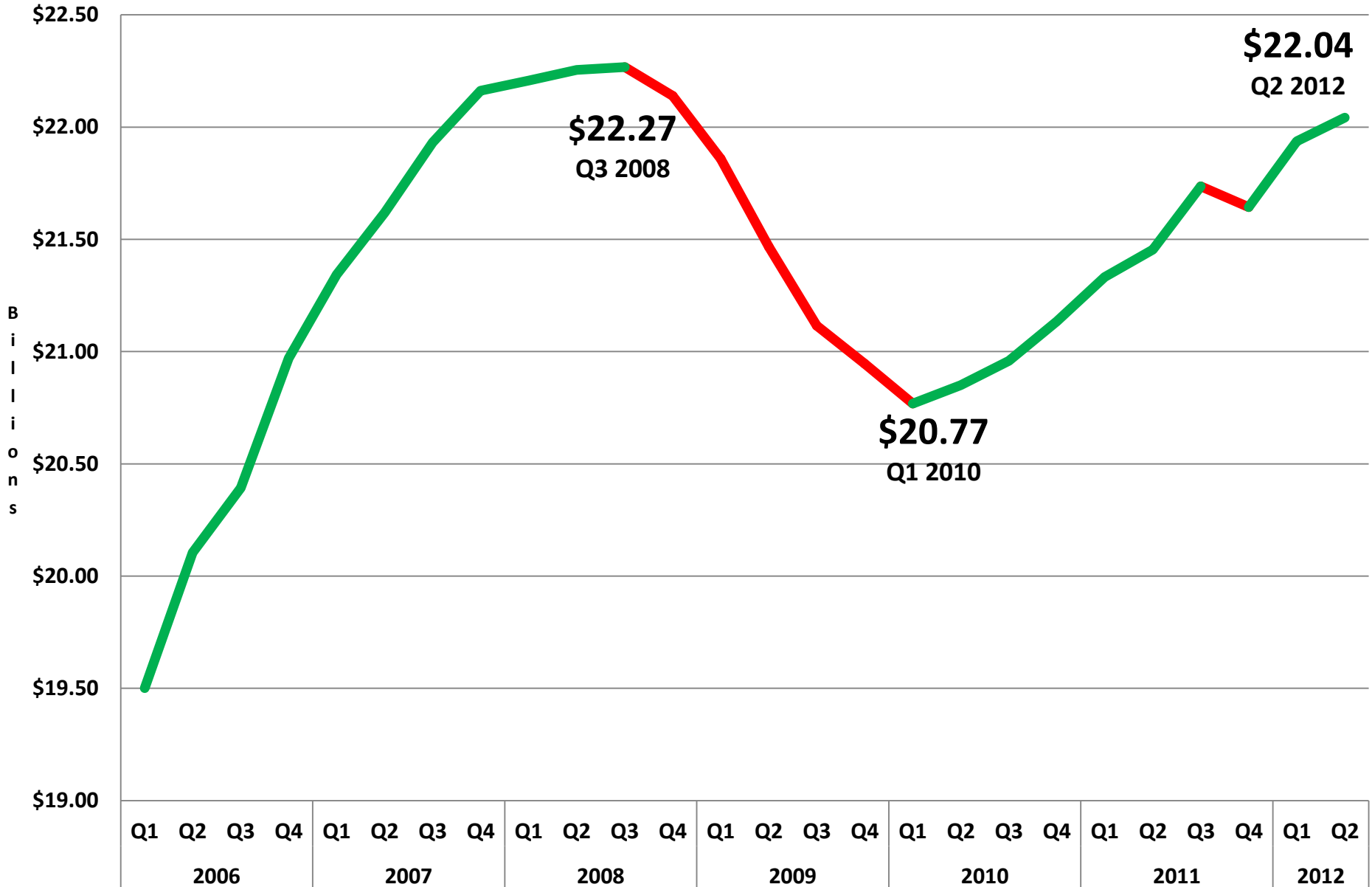

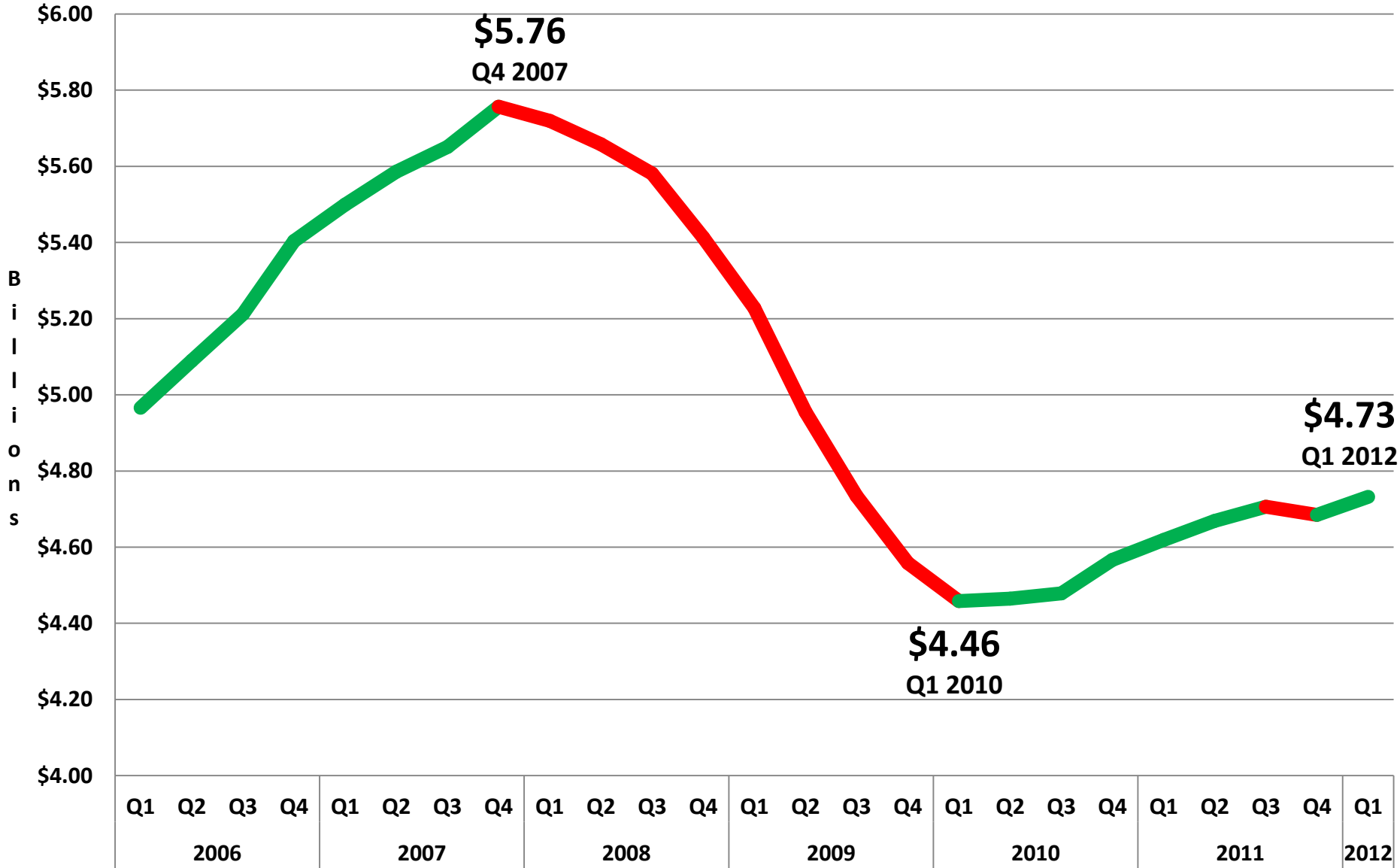
Idaho Wages

Annualized on a Quarterly Basis



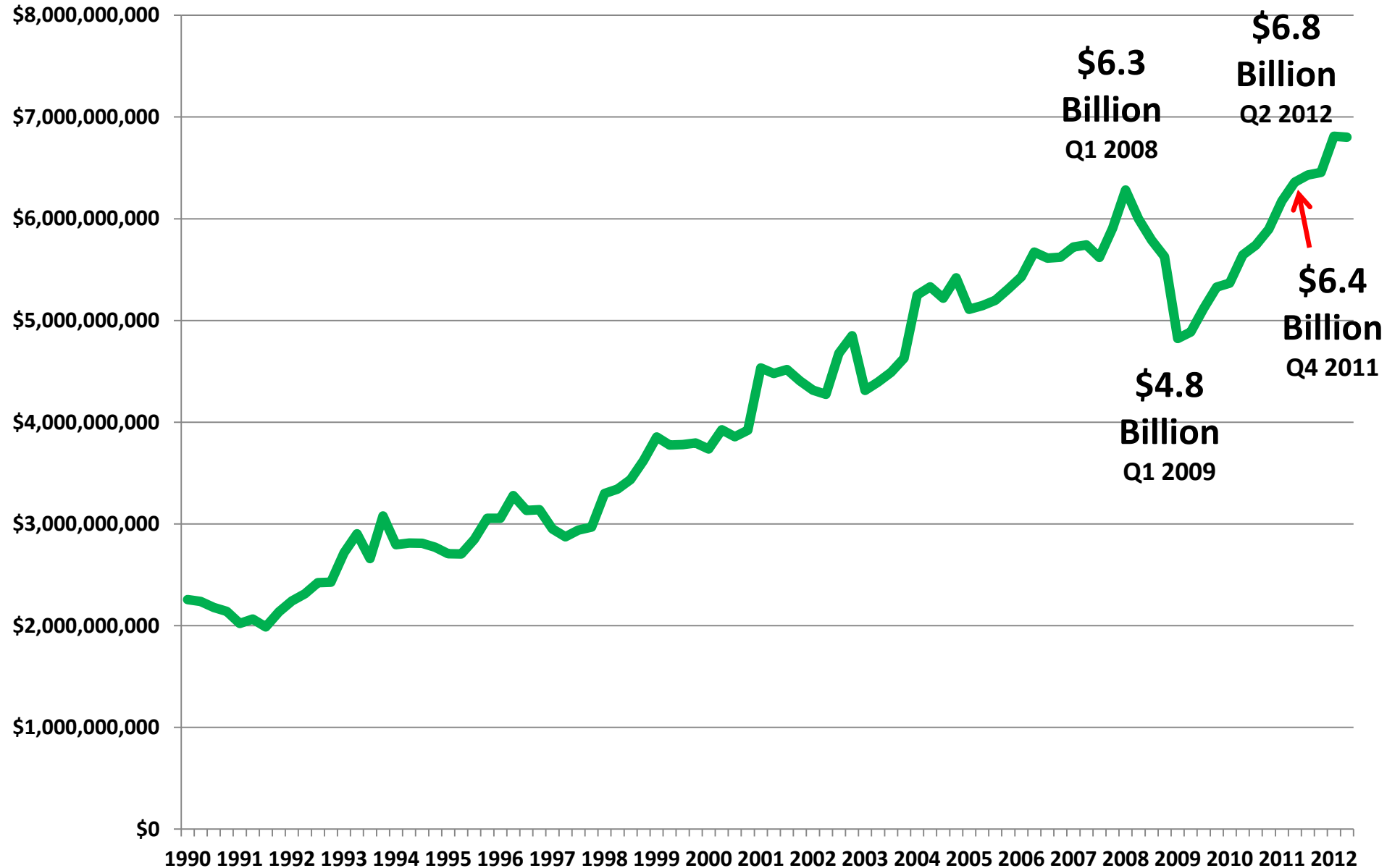
Goods Production Wages

Annualized on a Quarterly Basis

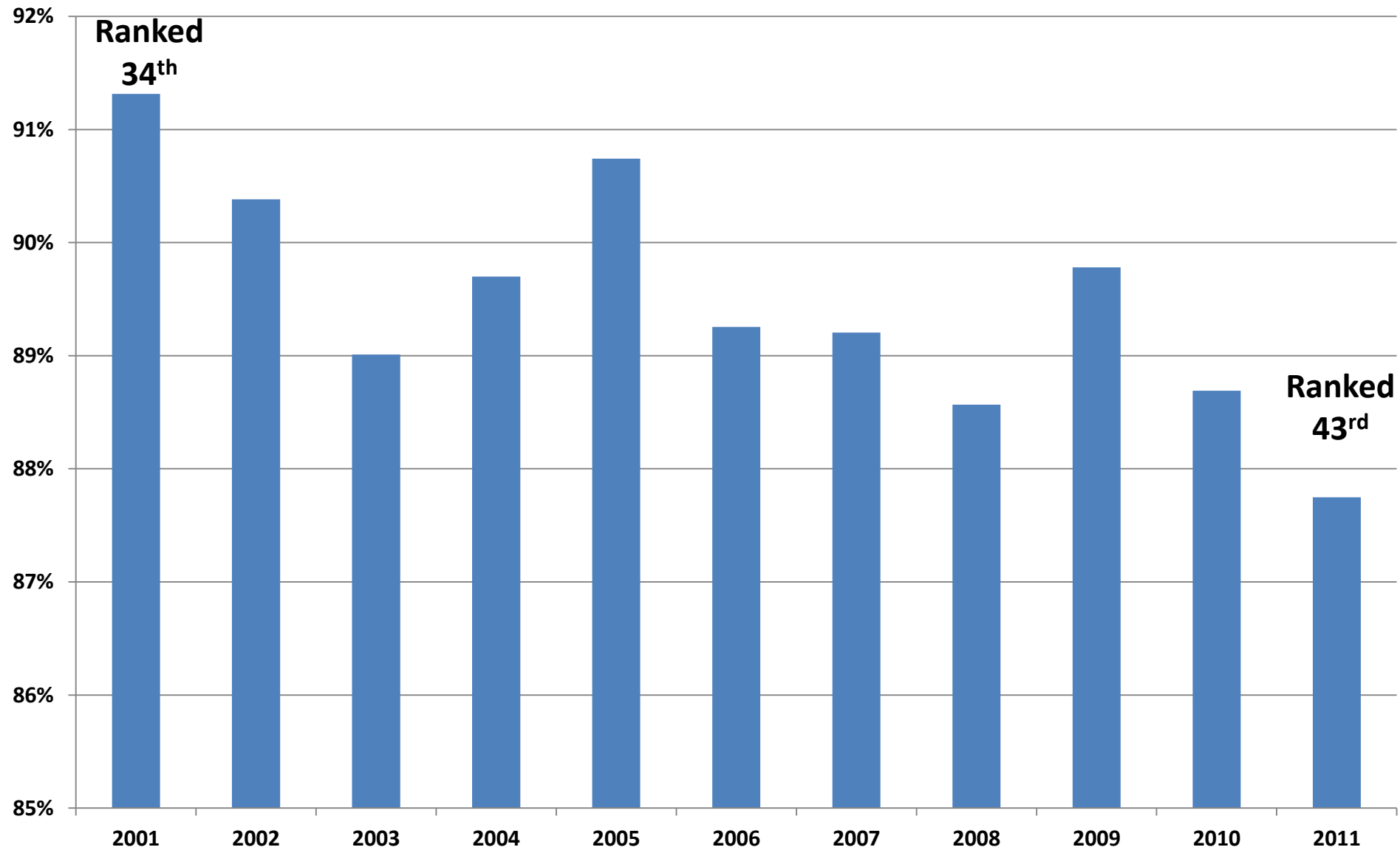


Idaho Business Profits

Annualized on a Quarterly Basis

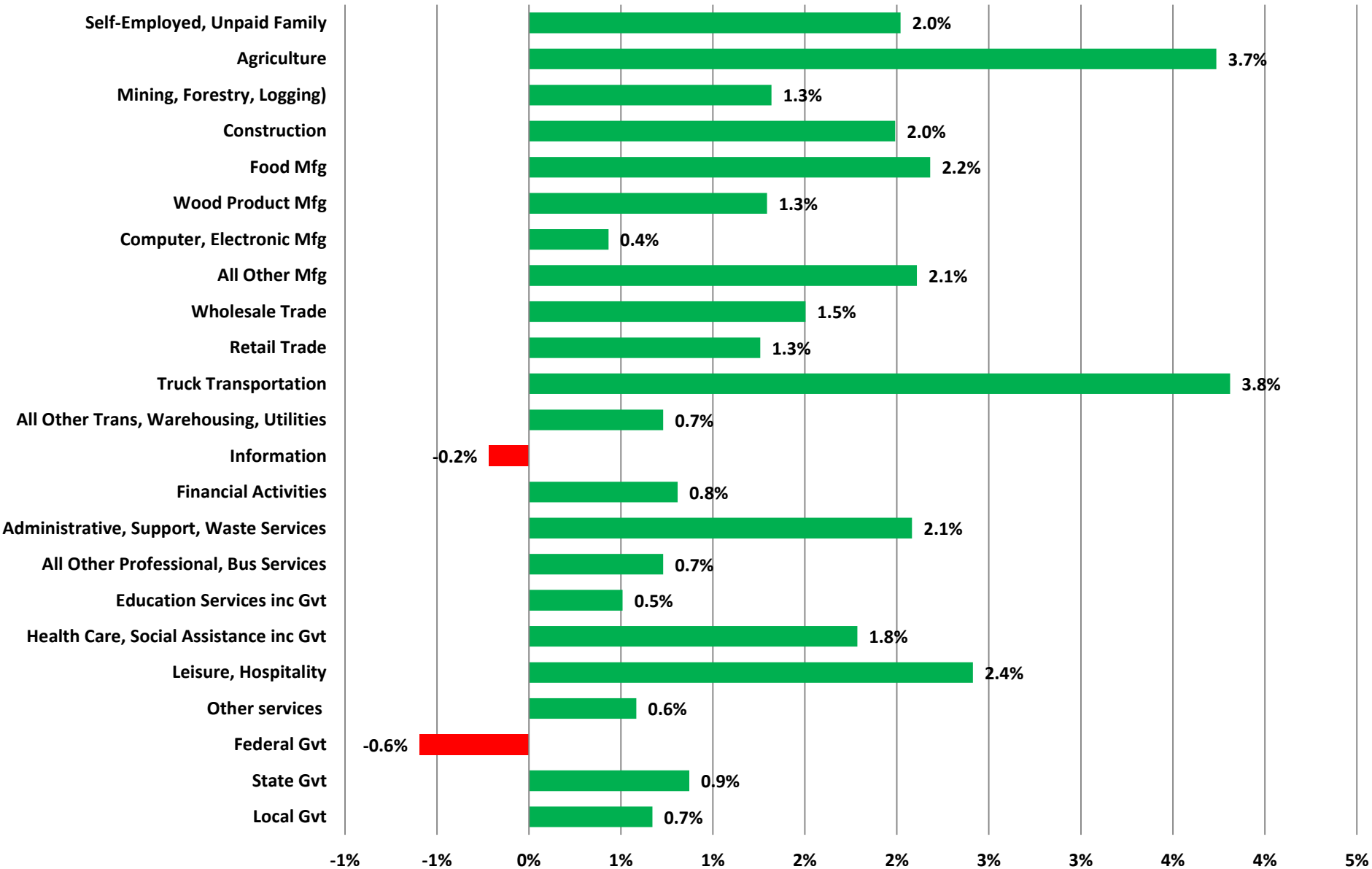


Idaho Median Wage as Percent of National Median Wage



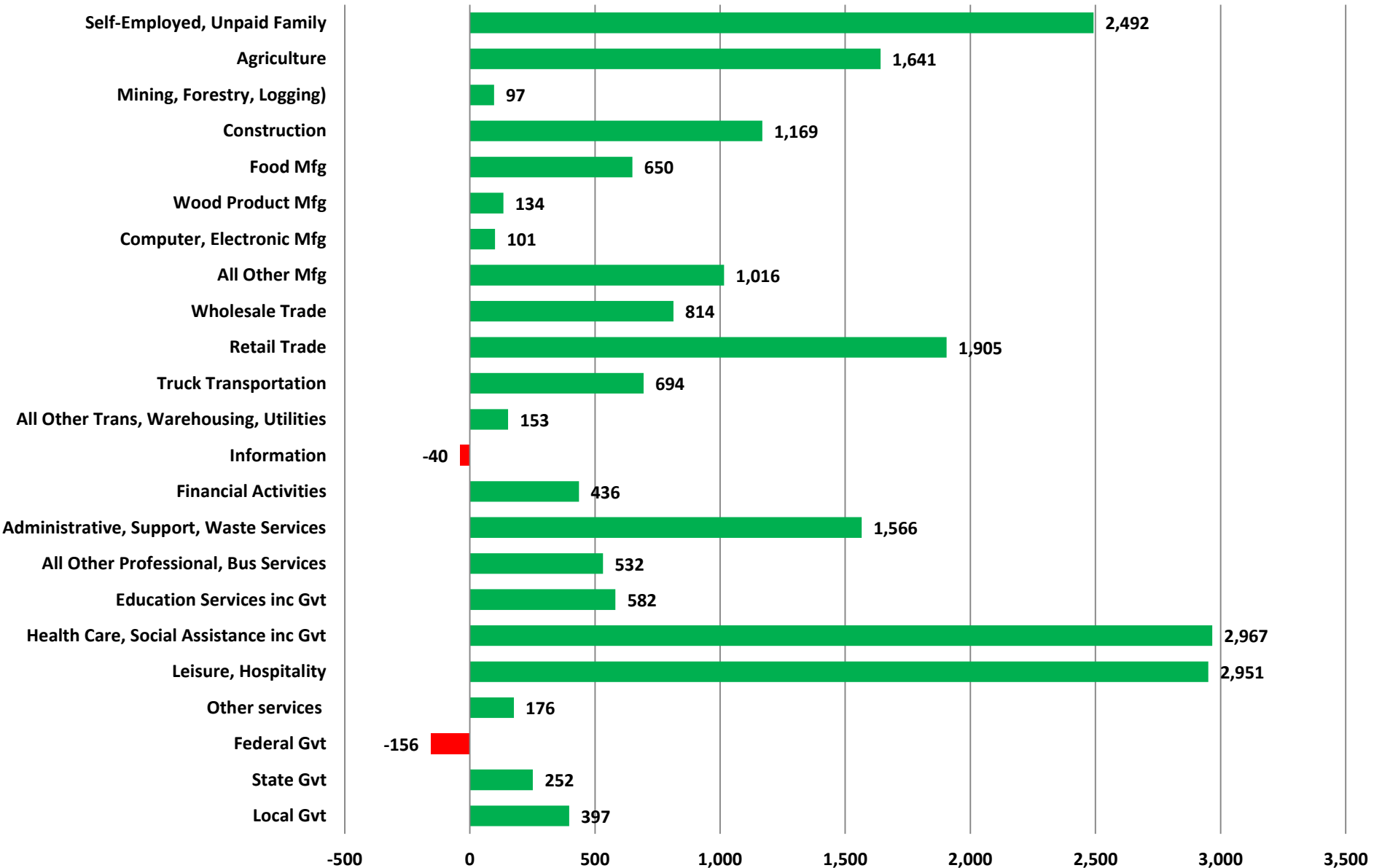
Idaho Job Projections

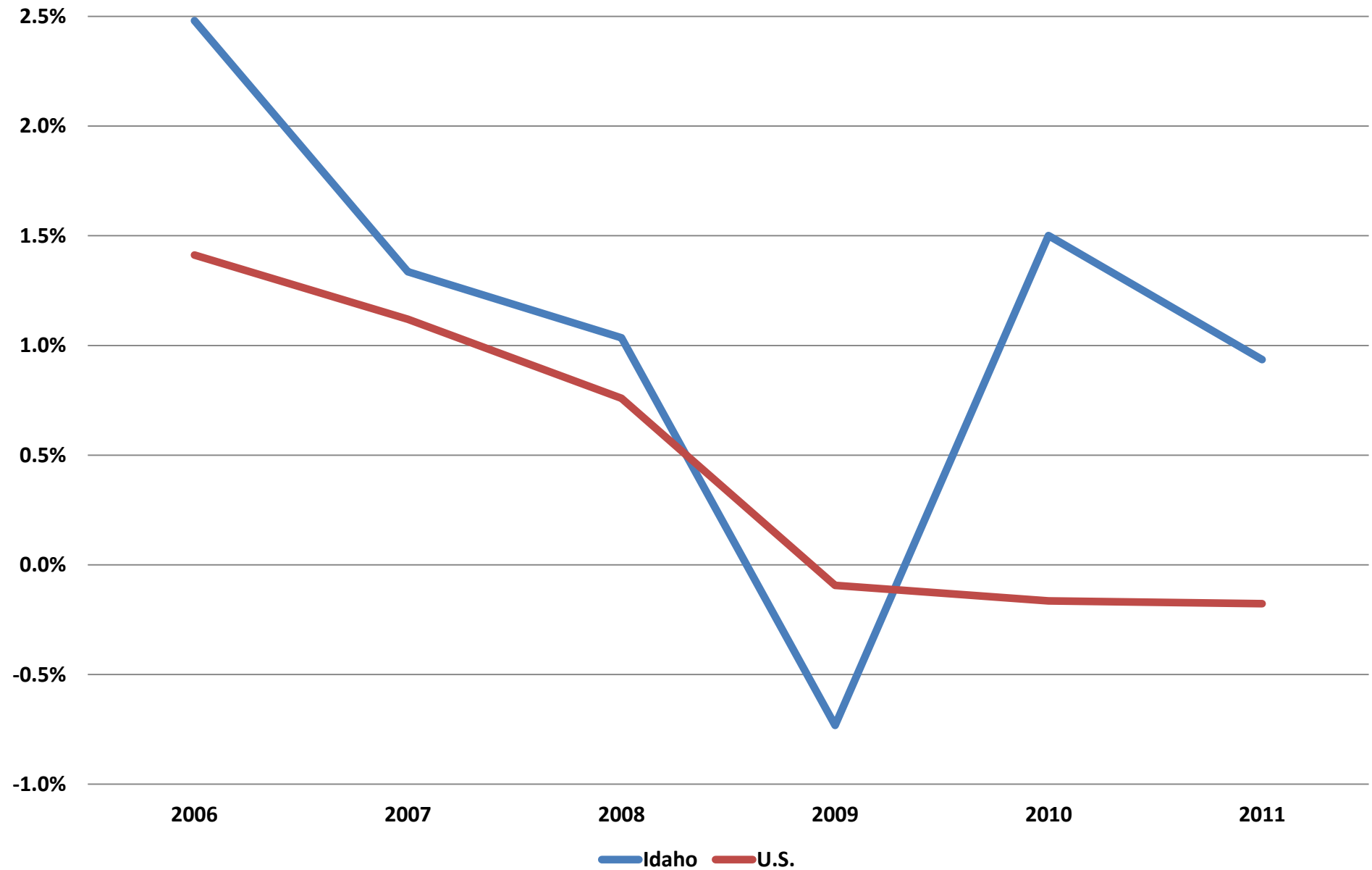

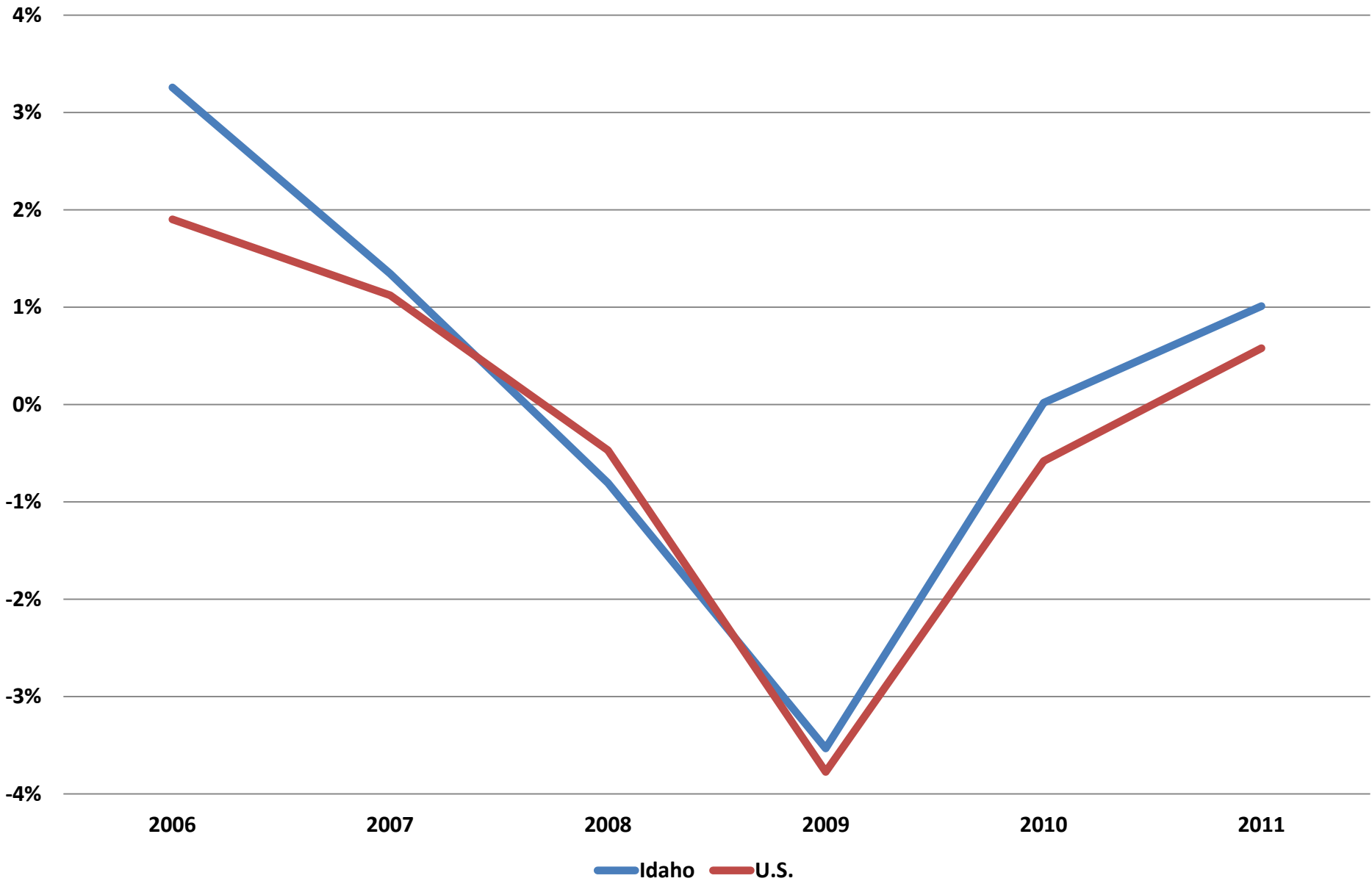
Percentage Change in Labor Force

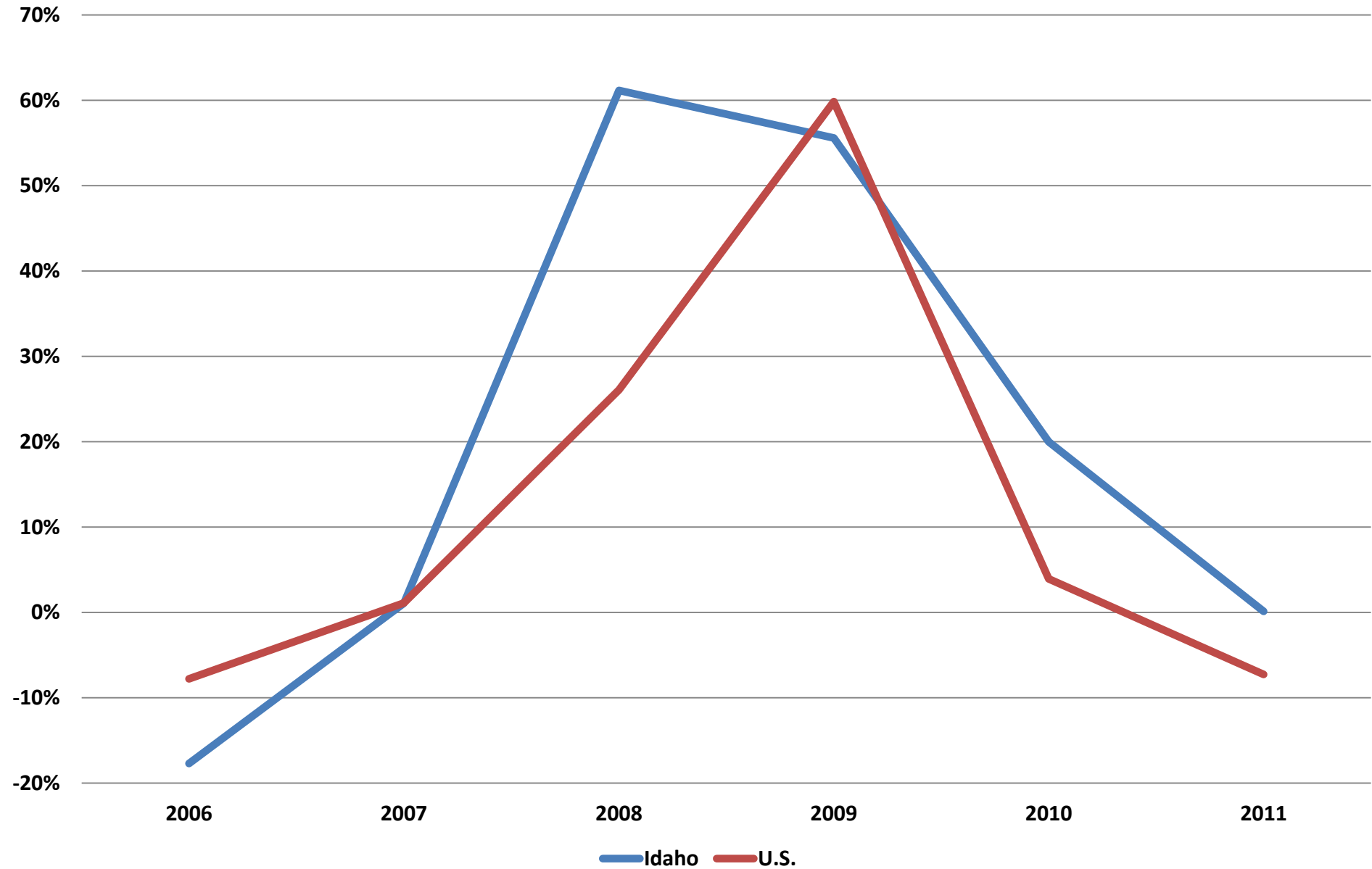
Percentage Change in Employment

From 2005



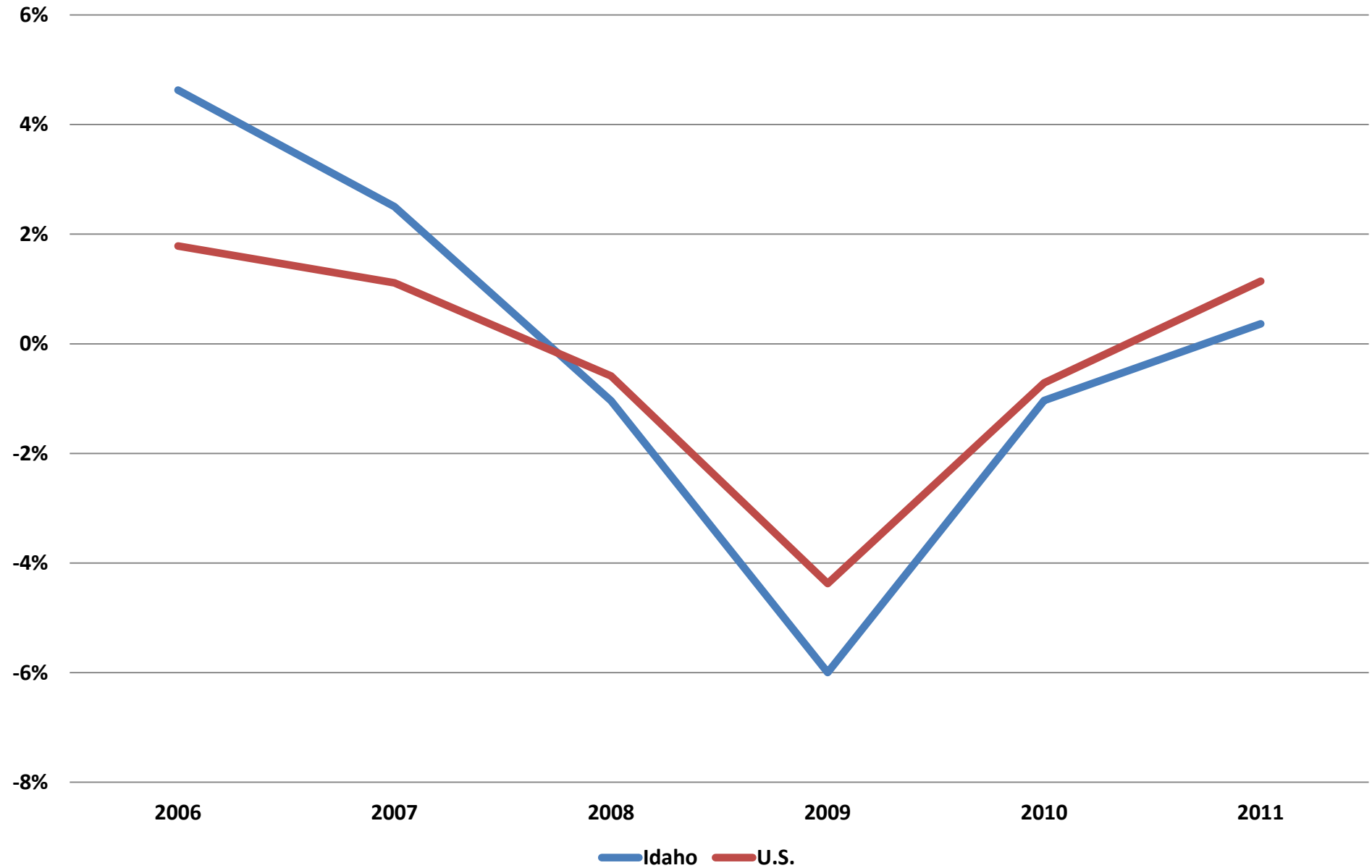
Percentage Change in Unemployment

from 2005



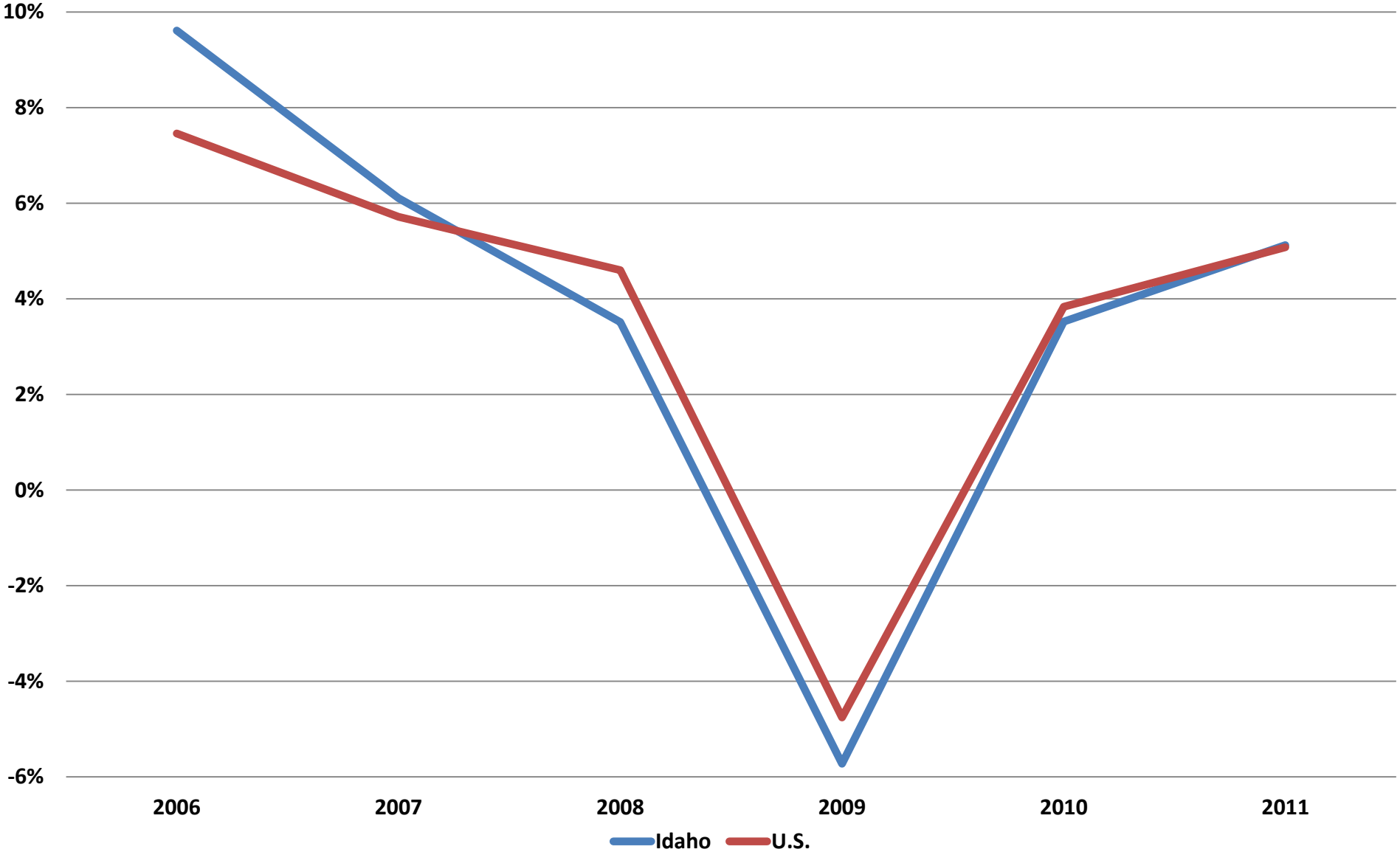
Percentage Change in Jobs

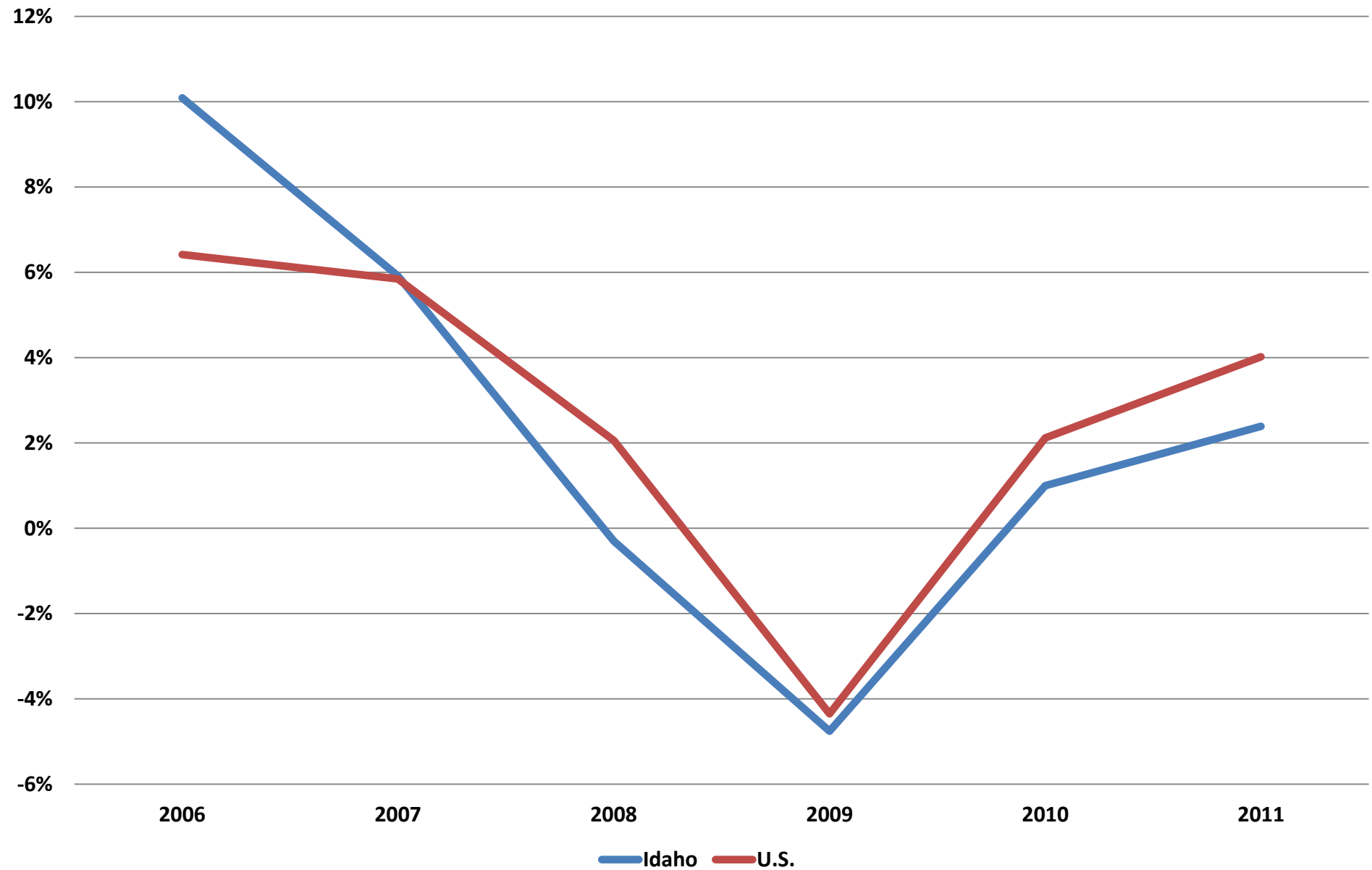
Percentage Change in Personal Income

From 2005



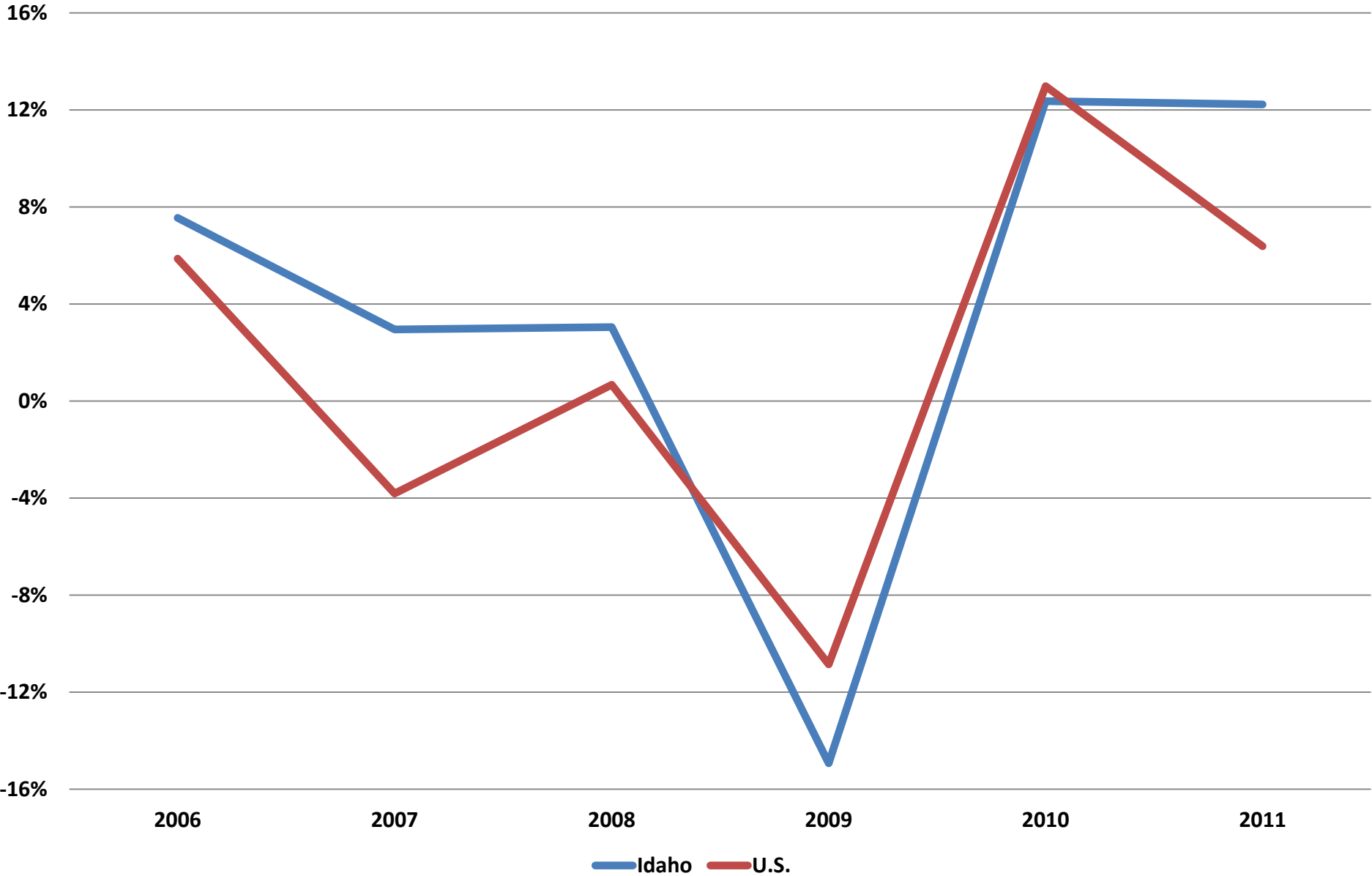
Percentage Change in Wages

From 2005



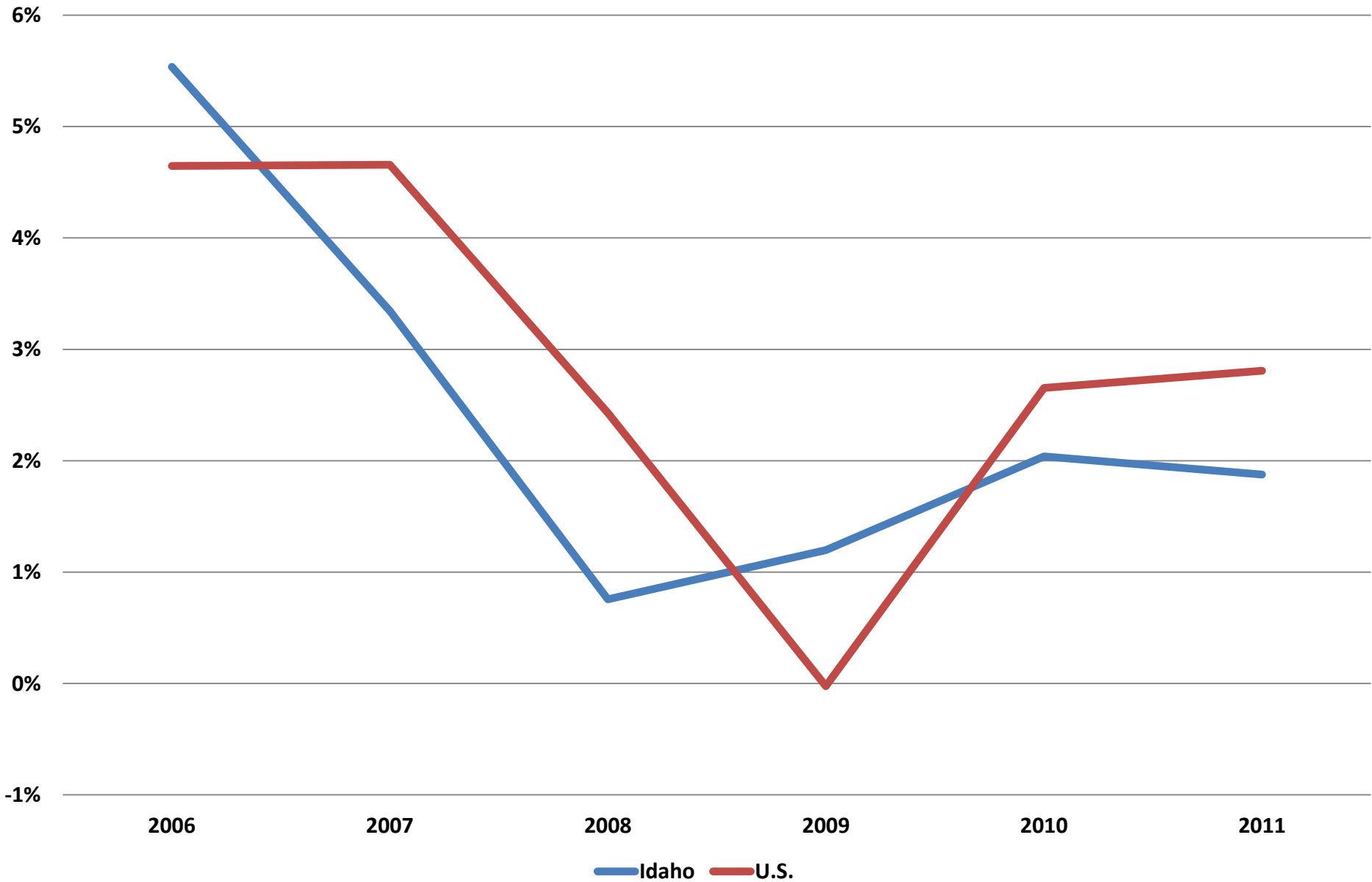
Percentage Change in Profits

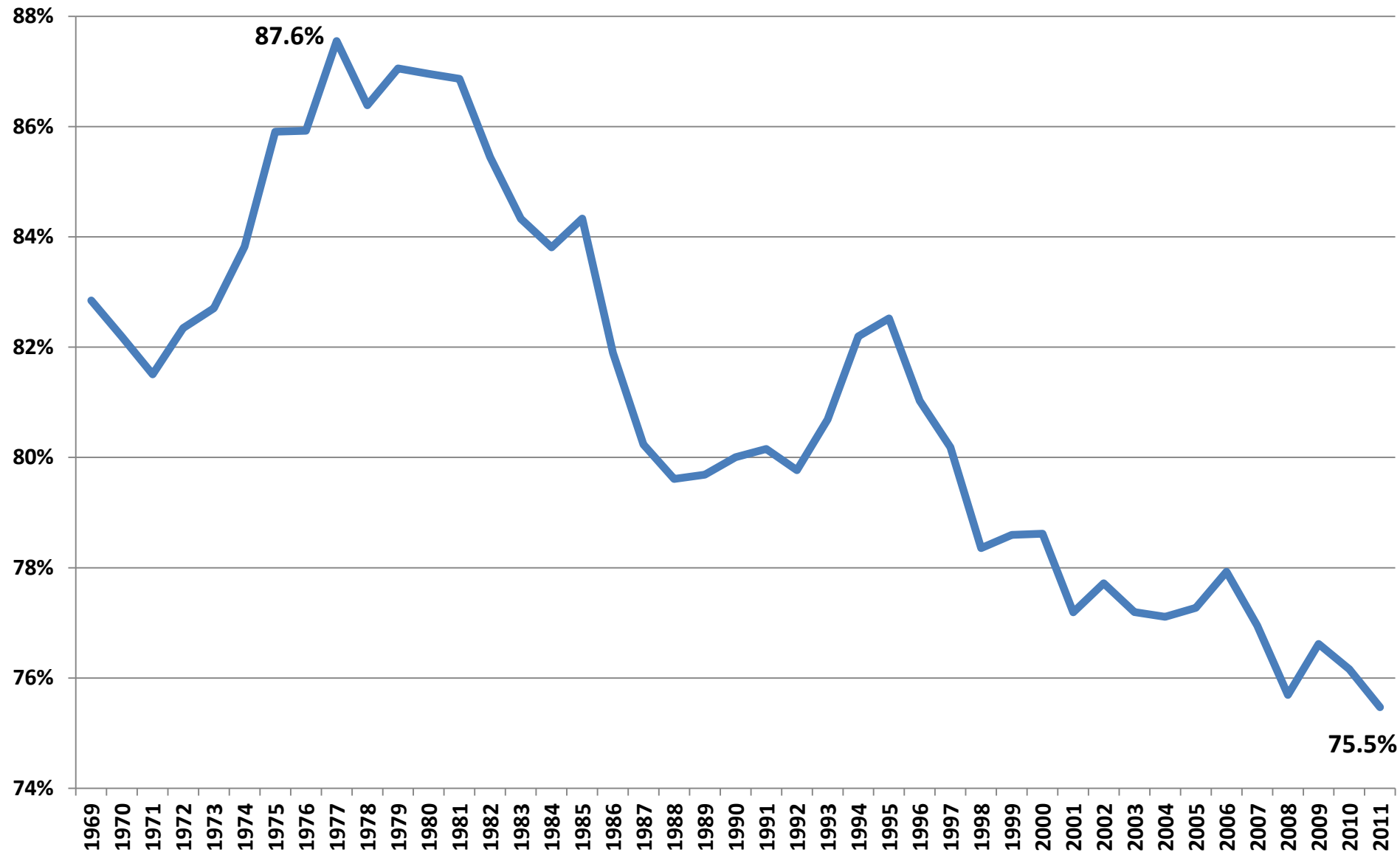

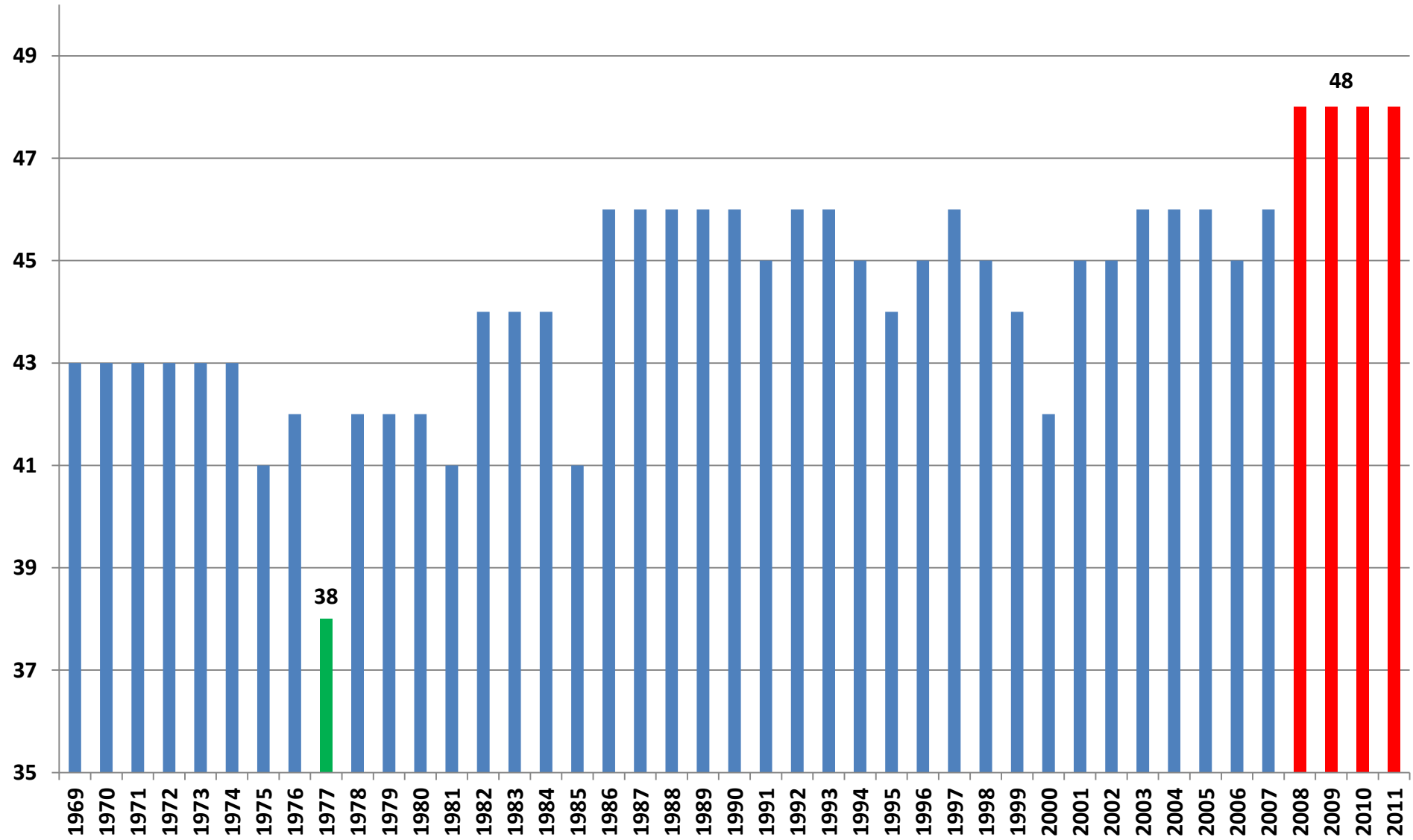

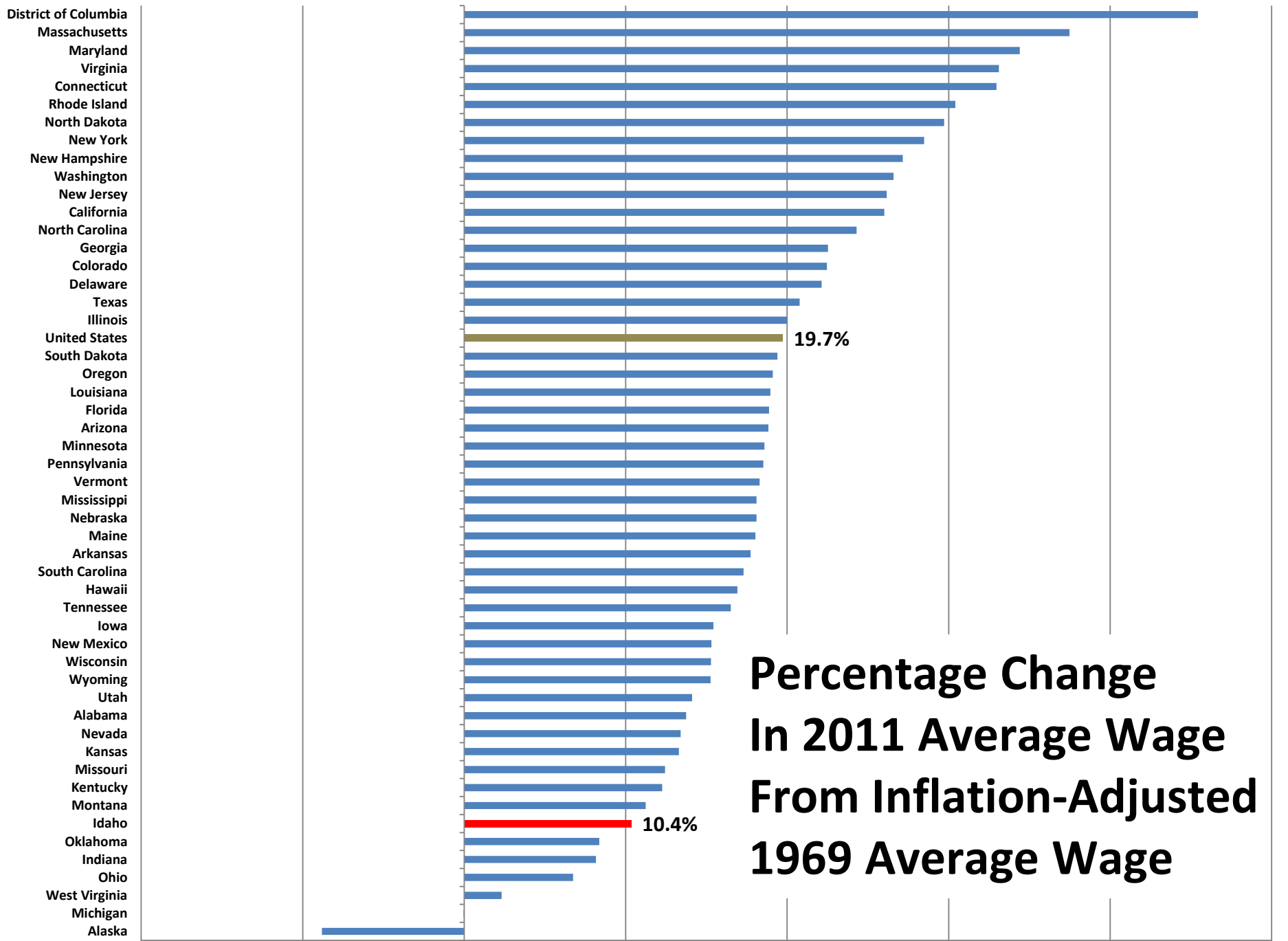

Idaho Average Wage as % Of U.S. Average Wage



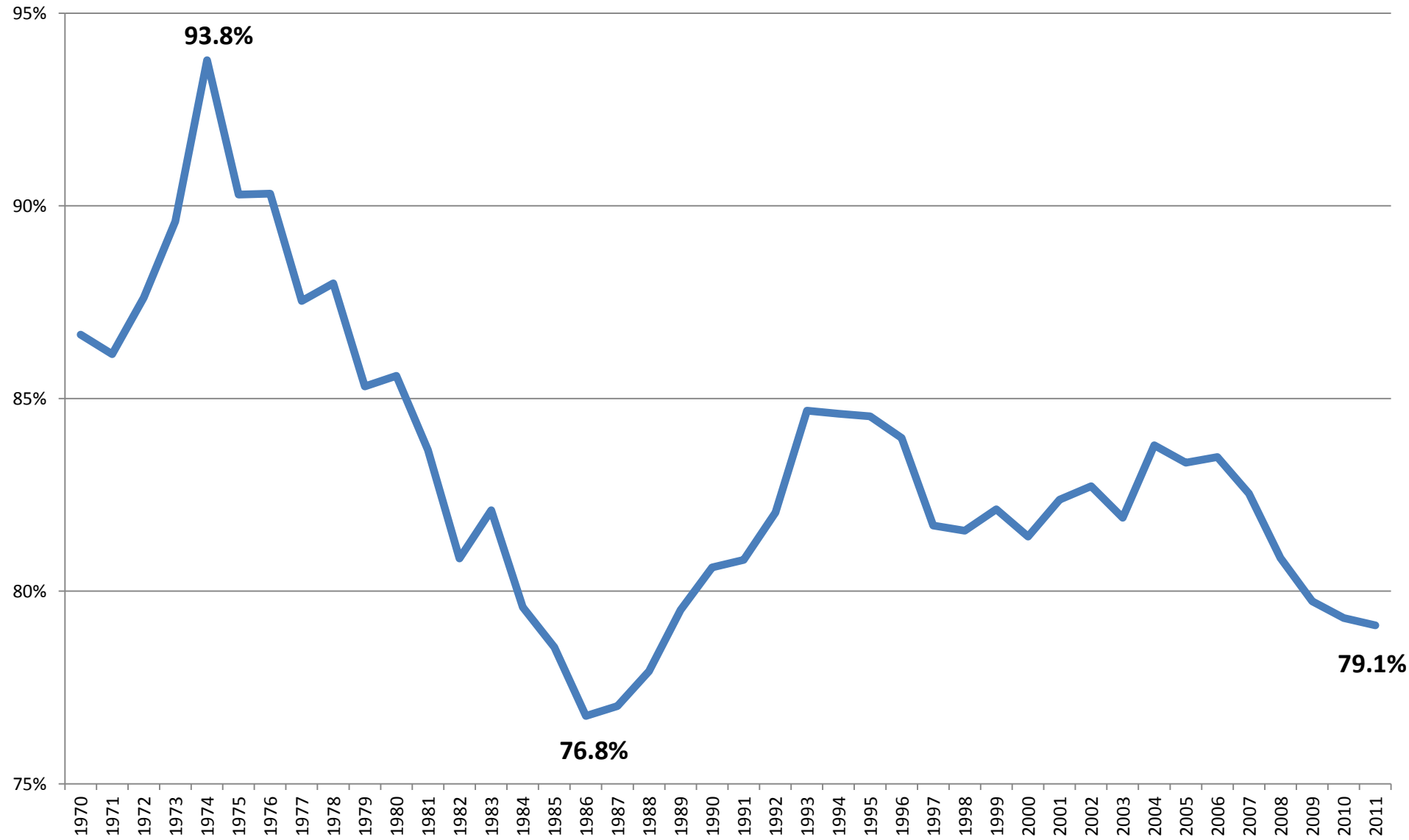
Rank of Idaho's Average Wage Among All States



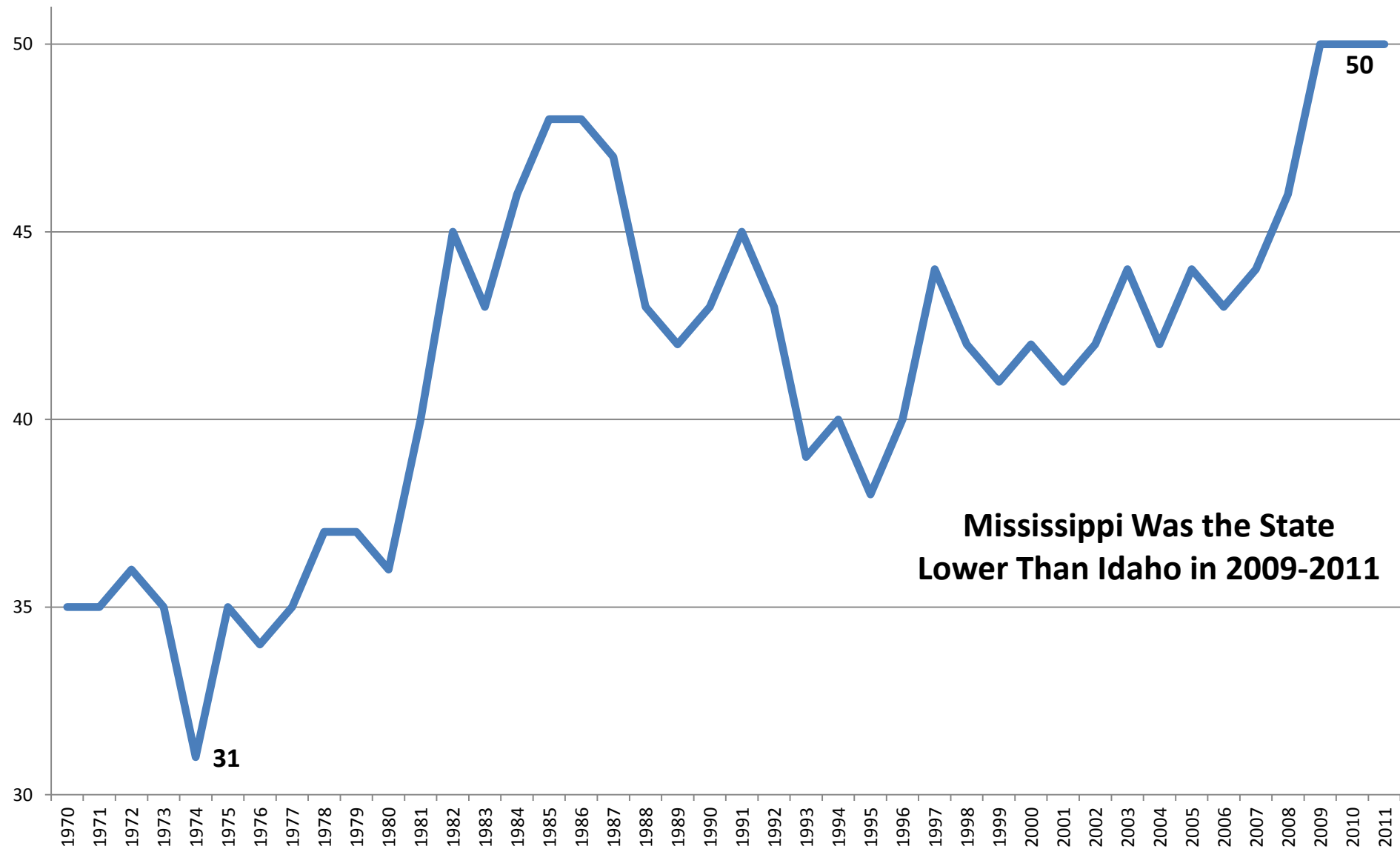
