PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Las Vegas – Clark County Urban League will utilize components of the Nevada Department of Corrections' Risk Assessment Instrument to assess participants' needs, as well as the use of a Developmental Matrix to determine the needs of participants around education, employability training, life skills development, legal issues, family reunification, mental/physical health, and substance abuse issues. These assessments will guide case management for participants and serve as individual development plans. Through partners, participants will be offered opportunities to pursue GEDs and post-secondary educational opportunities. Both through partners and through the Urban League, participants are provided with employment training and placement opportunities in high-growth, high-demand industries as well as other supportive services, such as life skills training. Mentoring will be provided by community recruits, found through the use of a mentor coordinator to provide outreach and training to mentors.
