<b>Project Description:</b>	This project is designed to enable the California Employment Development Department (EDD) and the Tulare Workforce Investment Board (TWIB) to design a pilot project that will 1) provide education, training and placement services for entry-level <i>promotoras</i> candidates, and 2) provide additional skills training to incumbent <i>promotoras</i> to improve portability of skills and foster career mobility.
<b>Proposed Outcomes:</b>	Total participants to be served – 75 (45 entry level and 30 incumbent workers) Total entry-level placed in employment – 30 Total number of retained six months after placement- 25 Total number of incumbent workers retained - 30
