Summer Jobs and Beyond: Career Pathways for Youth (CPY)

AGENCY: Employment and Training Administration, Department of Labor

ACTION: Amendment to FOA-ETA-16-08

SUMMARY: The Employment and Training Administration announced on February 4, 2016, the availability of funds and Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) for CPY grants to be awarded through a competitive process. This amendment to the FOA revises language in Section IV.B.(3)1(d) Violent Crime Rate.

The document is hereby amended as follows:

Section IV.B.(3)1(d) Violent Crime Rate

This section is amended to update the link for obtaining the violent crime rate.

Old language (Paragraph 1):

(d) Violent Crime Rate:

The applicant must provide the violent crime rate, per 100,000 inhabitants, for their Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA), as provided by the Federal Bureau of Investigation in this chart:<https://www.fbi.gov/about-us/cjis/ucr/crime-in-the-u.s./2013/crime-in-the-u.s.-2013/tables/6tabledatadecpdf/table-6>. If a target community does not align with one of the MSAs in the chart, the applicant must provide the requested data from an alternative source and must provide the citation for the rate provided. The rate should be provided per 100,000 inhabitants, if possible.

New language (replacement language in bold):

(d) Violent Crime Rate: The applicant must provide the violent crime rate, per 100,000 inhabitants, for their Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA), as provided by the Federal Bureau of Investigation in **Table 6 from the 2013 Uniform Crime Statistics:**

- Go to www.fbi.gov
- Select “Stats and Services” from the links across the top of the screen and then select “Crime Statistics/UCR” from the dropdown
- Select the link for “2013” from the Uniform Crime Reports, *Crimes in the U.S.* section

- **Select “Go To Offense Tables” link at the bottom of Offenses Known to Law Enforcement section**
- **Select Table 6 from the Data Tables on the far right**
- **Report on the Violent Crime Rate per 100,000 inhabitants for the MSA in response to this criterion**

If a target community does not align with one of the MSAs in the chart, the applicant must provide the requested data from an alternative source and must provide the citation for the rate provided. The rate should be provided per 100,000 inhabitants, if possible.
