**Reentry Projects**

**AGENCY:** Employment and Training Administration (ETA), Labor

**ACTION:** Amendment to FOA-ETA-17-02

**SUMMARY:** The Employment and Training Administration announced on March 21, 2017, the availability of funds and Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) for Reentry Projects to be awarded through a competitive process. This amendment to the FOA adds text to Section II. B. “Period of Performance” and removes language from Section IV.B.2, “Project Budget”.

The document is hereby amended as follows.

**Section IV.B.3, “Project Budget”**

**Removed Text:**

“As mentioned in Section II.B., the proposed budget must ensure that adequate funding (a minimum of five percent) is set aside to support the required twelve-month follow-up period. The budget should adequately reflect this allotment.”

**Section II.B., “Period of Performance”**

Section II.B., “Period of Performance,” is amended to clarify the following sentence regarding the planning and follow-up periods, as follows:

**Old Text:**

“These grants have a performance period of 36 months, which includes a planning period, period of operation, and follow-up period; the period of operation must be at least 24 months of the total period of performance.”

**New Text:**

“These grants have a performance period of 36 months, which includes a 3 month planning period, 24 month period of operation, and 9 month follow-up period.”
