<b>Project Description</b>	Iowa proposes to focus on high-level capacity building between major employers in the construction industry. This capacity building centers on filling at least 1,500 construction occupations, a majority of which will be via Registered Apprenticeship. Iowa has an unprecedented level of major public and private construction projects occurring as a result of recovery from natural disasters, new business development, and an upswing in new housing starts. As part of the capacity building in this funding opportunity, two major construction industry associations will share project operators with close technical assistance from the State.
