Project Description	Michigan will implement the JD NEG as a statewide project. The State will provide work-based learning through Registered Apprenticeships, on-the-job training (OJT), internships, externships, and customized training, as well as simulation/project-based learning activities and accelerated skills training along career pathways that lead to an industry-recognized credential and employment. Additionally, Michigan plans to use JD NEG funds to enhance its Regional Online Job Demand Profiles using the Conference Board Help Wanted On-line (HWOL) Data Series, as well as for the development of partnership strategies.

Populations to be Served	Dislocated workers that are long-term unemployed, Unemployment Insurance (UI) recipients that have been profiled as likely to exhaust UI benefits, and foreign-trained workers who are faced with barriers to obtaining employment within their trained field or profession. Priority will be given to recently separated veterans
