**PURPOSE:** To transmit the Office of Apprenticeship Training, Employer and Labor Services (OATELS), Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training (BAT) Staff an official list of occupations recognized as apprenticeable.

The letters "CB" has been added as an extension of the RAIS Code to identify they are a Competency-Based program i.e., 1067 would become 1067CB. All other codes will remain the same.

**BACKGROUND:** The attached list of occupations is recognized as apprenticeable by OATELS. Occupations that have been approved by the SAC that are not recognized by OATELS are not included on the list.

Twenty-six occupations have been recognized as apprenticeable since the last list was issued.
