State Labor Market Information Improvement Grants (LMI)

Goals:

- The development of methods for estimating the impact on industry & occupational employment from implementation of green technologies.
- The dissemination of data on the occupational skills & growing needs of the energy efficiency & renewable energy industries.
- The development of research that provides insight into green industries.
- The posting of job openings highlighted for easy recognition as green jobs.



State Energy Sector Partnership (SESP) & Training Grants

Goals:

- Support States in implementing a statewide energy sector strategy that lead to employment in targeted industry sectors;
- Build partnerships dedicated to building a skilled energy efficiency & renewable energy workforce;
- Develop new partnerships with other agencies to support strategic planning and implementation efforts;
- Create an integrated system of education, training, and supportive services leading to employment in green industries.



Pathways Out of Poverty Grants

Goals:

- Recruitment and referral strategies for targeted populations;
- Integrate basic skills and work readiness training with occupational skills training;
- Combine supportive services with training services to help participants overcome barriers to employment, as necessary; and
- Provide training services at times and locations that are easily accessible to targeted populations.



Energy Training Partnership Grants (ETP)

Goals:

- Provide training and placement in energy efficiency & renewable energy industries
- All training and placement activities will be conducted at the local level.
- A portion of the total funds will serve communities impacted by automotive industry related restructuring.



Health Care Sector and Other High Growth and Emerging Industries Grants

Goals:

- Develop the pipeline of credentialed healthcare workers;
- Support local partnerships in executing integrated job placement and training strategies and,
- Support training and articulation agreements with accredited institutions that lead to industry-recognized, portable credentials.
