


American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

- Increase number and proportion of customers who receive training


Total Number of WIA Participants and Exiters PY 2000-2008


Total Number of WIA Adult Participants and Exitters PY 2000-2008


Total New WIA Participants by Program May/June - October 2009

Focus of Recovery Act


For WIA Adults and Dislocated Workers Programs; National Emergency Grants:

PY 2003 - 2007



Low-Income as a Percent of Total WIA Adult Exiters




Total WIA Adults by Selected Characteristics October 2009


Percent of WIA Adult Exiters Receiving Training PY 2007


Total Number of WIA Participants Trained PY 2005-2008


WIA Adult Training Services PY 2001 - 2007


Total WIA Adults by Training Characteristics October 2009

Total WIA Adult Participants in Training October Program to Date



Active WIA Adults by Training Characteristics


May/June - October 2009


Total WIA Adult Participants in OJT October Program to Date


Change in Number Receiving Training PY 2008 Q1 and PY 2009 Q1


Total Number of WIA Dislocated Worker Participants and Exiters PY 2000-2008


Total WIA Dislocated Workers by Selected Characteristics October 2009


Percent of WIA DW Exiters Receiving Training PY 2007

Total Number of WIA Participants Trained PY 2005-2008





Total WIA Dislocated Workers by Training Characteristics October 2009



Active WIA Dislocated Workers by Training Characteristics


May/June - October 2009



- Referral to WIA services


Total New Wagner-Peyser Participants by Program May/June - October 2009


Total Wagner-Peyser Employment Service by Selected Characteristics October 2009


Total Wagner-Peyser ES Participants October Program to Date


Total Wagner-Peyser Reemployment Services by Selected Characteristics October 2009



PY 2000-2008




Total WIA Youth by Selected Characteristics October 2009

Total WIA Youth Participants in Summer Employment October Program to Date




Give us your best data!

Performance Accountability

- Check distributions
 - Should the male/female ratio be 80/20?
- Compare data over time
 - Are there any significant shifts in the data?
- Watch for related fields
 - If a customer received OJT (WIASRD 340), in what occupation was the customer trained (WIASRD 342)?


States Missing Training Occupations - WIA Adult Exiters PY 2007

Performance Accountability

- Submit the data on time
 - Cross-train so that more than one person can submit the data
- Limit the number of data revisions
- Check data ranges
 - We have seen data from exiters born during the Renaissance

Performance Accountability

- Populate optional fields when possible
 - Tell a complete and compelling story
- Check totals
 - For the WIA Annual Report, table M should be “equal” to the sum of the totals for locals in table O
- Read *Understanding the WIA 9090 Report Counts*

Performance Accountability

- Compare Locals
 - Are there any significant differences in the data?
- Appropriate occurrences of dates
 - Date of Qualifying Dislocation for a Dislocated Worker should be before the exit date
- Compare rolling four quarter data for the quarter ending June 30 to your Annual Report and WIASRD data




