# Career Pathways: Four Key Ingredients

1. Sequence of education and training credentials coupled with relevant career steps – “Career Pathway Map”
  - Sector-based with close working relationships with employers
  - Multiple entry and exit points
2. Wrap around support services
3. Partnerships
4. Program innovation
  - Contextualization, acceleration, modularization
  - Adult education bridge programs
