The decision to move the PCB business is due to opportunities the Cooper acquisition has offered with regards to operational and cost synergies. The Tijuana facility has PCB manufacturing capabilities and with room to grow while the Watertown facility needs room to grow two other existing businesses – Variable Frequency Drives and solar inverters.



